

Medical clinic and Maternity home Chingele, Zimbabwe

Chingele is a rural village in Zimbabwe. Nearest major city is Chiridzi about an hours drive away in ideal conditions. The majority of the people in this rural area do not have electricity and their water is gathered by buckets from various bore holes (wells) in the area. It's a farming community and the welfare of the people is very much dependent on the how well crops and livestock thrive or not.

Chingele has a privately run clinic that is dependent on donations for it to function properly. They also have a maternity home for woman to stay at before and right after giving birth as the area is large, remote, and can be difficult for a medical professional to get to woman when their time has come.
