## Tips To Stay Safe Online

### Impersonation & Unexpected Messages

- Scammers may pretend to be government agencies, banks, or family members.
- If a message demands urgent payment or personal information, it may be a scam.



### Protect Your Personal Information

- Never share passwords, banking information, or personal details with unknown contacts.
- Create passwords with letters, numbers, and symbols, and use different passwords for each account.
- A password manager can help you store them safely.



### Report Fraud Immediately

- If you suspect fraud, contact the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre.
- Reporting scams helps protect others from becoming victims.
