TREASURER'S REPORT

I would like to present my report for the financial year ending on December 31, 2018. For the year 2018, our total revenue was \$7,591 and our operating expenses were 5,869. As of December 31, 2018, our net assets were \$3,346. For the financial year ending on December 31, 2018, the income tax return was filed through Abrar Naseer, CPA, CGA.

The sources of revenue generation for MWC in 2018 were annual membership fees, ongoing donations and annual fundraising event called International Women's Day. MWC activities and services are also supported through in-kind contributions from its members, partners and other stakeholders. The Board of Directors of Malton Women Council continue to make efforts to receive funding to support our programs and services.






