Lice Education

What are Head Lice?

Head lice (Pediculus Humanus Capitis - plural) are tiny, six-legged parasitic insects that live on human heads and feed on human blood by biting the scalp. Human blood is necessary for survival. A louse can not live more than 2 days without feeding on a human host.

Adult female lice lay eggs (Nits) just above the scalp along the hair shaft, which in about a weeks time hatch into baby lice (called Nymphs). Nits are most often found in the hair at the back of the neck or behind the ears; that area best provides the warmth, darkness and food that they need for survival at that stage of life. Nymphs are capable of reproducing in about a weeks time. A female louse can lay about 10-15 nits daily for their 30 day average life span.

Signs and Symptoms

Often spotting a live louse (singular) or nymph is the only sign of an infestation. The presence of nits alone does not confirm an infestation. The most common symptoms are itching, scratching, or irritation that may start weeks after the lice move in. In some rare cases, the bug bites mixed with frequent scratching can


cause an allergic reaction resulting in sores or raw skin on the scalp. If redness or severe irritation occurs, please contact your doctor or pediatrician immediately.

Head Lice at School

Some schools have a "No-Nit" policy, meaning that ALL eggs must be removed before the child returns to the classroom. To prevent possible school absences, or parents missing time at work, have your child's head checked or treated by a CLR lice removal specialist immediately.

Prevention and Control

As a parent, your best defense is to examine your child's hair and scalp regularly so you can catch an infestation early. Prompt treatment will help prevent the bugs from spreading to the rest of the family. Head lice are primarily transferred from human to human by direct contact or by several people sharing the same brushes, combs, hats, clothes, athletic equipment, towels, headphones, pillows and blankets. Using preventative products (shampoos, conditioners, repellents) on your child's head before school, sleepovers, camps or when exposed to lice can greatly decrease the risk of infestation.



Our Process

<u>Evaluation</u>: we thoroughly examine the hair and scalp for live lice and any visible nits.

<u>Treatment</u>: we spray and saturate the hair and scalp with our non-toxic and pesticide free enzyme to help eliminate lice and aid us in our combing by loosening the glue that holds the nits (eggs) to the hair shaft.

<u>Nitpicking</u>: we utilize a strand-by-strand hair removal method with a fine tooth lice nit comb to remove all lice and their eggs.

Education: we thoroughly educate parents with proven prevention tips and accurate lice information. we also demonstrate to parents simple at home combing techniques that can be performed to increase effectiveness and also to treat and prevent possible future re-infestations.
