I got one call from one person saying they couldn't make it. Needless to say I'm a little bit upset because I'm just trying to go by our policy and make sure we have one every three months. I don't know what happened but we'll try and schedule one for march and go from there. Any new GSRs?

Secretary Report: Previous months minutes read by Lauren P. – copies were distributed and reviewed.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer's report was distributed and reviewed by Craig F.

Craig – I talked to Lynn, the RSO treasurer and she got everything but she just asked that next time we write the insurance check to the RSO, I wrote it to region. The bank charges us a statement fee but they are sending us double statements so I'm going to check on that.

Lauren – would one of them maybe be for E&A? Craig – they're sending doubles for both us and E&A.

Robin – since we're below what we should be we need to build this back up, just keep in mind

that we're a little low when you're bringing donations. Motion to accept by Michael J. and seconded by Lexi

Policy and Procedure:

John M – thank you for electing me, I'll do my best. Over the course of the last month I received all the archives from Aisha. It was a big crate of stuff and a lot of it was over 5 years old. What I did receive that's important is folders containing all the past policy minutes and copies of policy and each year it was updated, a binder containing subcommittee handbooks that is kind of outdated-I'd like a month to go through that one, and a binder containing OAA Meeting minutes 2012-2013. I have to say, a couple of those were missing in there but it was pretty full. I had better luck going on the website which goes back to 2014 and in the next month or so we need to look into if we have 3 years of archives or not and if we do where are they cause that's very important. Part of 2016 isn't on the website either and that's important also. I think if you're going to call for an admin body meeting we can take up those questions then so we don't take up all the time at area. One thing I did notice in going through the policies that is financial and could be rather important to us that we're going to have to involve the body with, is that somehow over the last few years we seem to have done away with the literature fund and we've just been buying literature and selling it but it is mixed in with our money. The truth is that at any point we could end up broke if they buy a lot of literature. I think we should establish a separate literature fund next month and maintain that separately and not as part of our money. It could get complicated but at some point we're going to have to do it, we used to before I don't know what happened or why we don't do it anymore.

Robin – as long as I've been around we've been doing it this way where they hand in money at the end of the night and when they order literature we pay. James tries not to buy any more than he sold the month before, he tries to keep in budget.

John – I can't tell you though how irresponsible it is that we don't keep track of that separately, we have no idea what we have or how much we're spending and how much of our money we need to keep the literature and that's our biggest asset.

Alexis – how do you do that? On the treasurer's report is says what's sold and then we have receipt on what was spent so how do we not know?

John – what I'm saying is we take the literature money and we mix it right in to the general fund. We don't know how much we need for literature and how much we can have.

Robin – well it's a line item on our reports

John – only how much we sold

Robin – but we also have all the checks we write as a line item

Alexis – what I'm saying is everything is recorded here so it should be

John – maybe you're not understanding. For 15 years we had a literature fund, we knew how much literature we had and how much money we had in the fund, we have no idea anymore. Craig – I think the point is that in most groups, there is a revolving book fund so that any book is sold can be replaced and that money is never mixed in with the money. So if we did that here, the literature person doesn't have to worry about whether or not we sold literature. So if something happens and they don't sell that much, then they can't buy literature and we have to write them a check. This would avoid that.

Mark R. – I think what you're saying is that you want to know what the inventory is. John – it would have to be both literature and money and when you put it together it would equal a certain amount so there would be a cap. They just reported that we have \$2500, if James needs to order a lot of literature, we think we have 2500 but we don't. We have nothing because our operating fund got used on literature. In the policy there's certain things that go in the literature fund and some that don't but we have no literature fund. So 3 months ago we had no literature and no money to buy more so we used our own money to do it but it can't stay that way

Robin – but he didn't buy anything this month.

John – that has nothing to do with it. Let's say he sells literature and there is a small mark up on the literature, that fund should grow and he should have more money to spend this way James knows what he can and can't buy.

Alexis – where does that money go though?

John – it stays in our bank account and the treasurer is still responsible for it.

Mark H – can we make a motion?

Robin – it's complicated, it should go to the policy committee. He needs to work out a procedure for it and then bring it back to the body.

John – okay so we'll do that. And we'll be meeting the 3rd Wednesday of each month in Monroe at 7:30 PM
