 - b. The EIN is to be used for banking purposes only. The Open Arms Area is an unincorporated group of individuals who provide non-medical, self-help atmosphere for those with drug problems to stop using drugs. We have no employees nor do we have a payroll.
 - c. Open Arms Area is not recognized as a non-profit organization, nor do we have tax-exempt status, so whatever you purchase, you must pay taxes on and provide itemized receipts.
 - d. When an Area Committee of NA acquires an EIN they should consider that the IRS could at some point contact them and request valid financial activity information. The Area must maintain detailed records including treasurers records, bank statements, detailed receipts and bill of sales for all purchases. Money disbursements should be clearly defined, the reason for the purchase, what items exactly were purchased and who the purchase was made from. These records must be kept for a minimum of five years. The Area does not have to file any yearly tax forms.
