The Epiphany Council wants to keep everyone informed about how we are doing financially. This month we will take a look back at February 2020.

The February numbers exceeded the projected February budget deficit by \$1,948.27.

The YTD numbers exceed the projected 2020 budget deficit by \$227.09.

#### **Please Help - Outreach Mission Grant**

Through the Transition Committee's work with Rev. Patti Axel at the Southeastern Synod, we have learned about an opportunity to receive a matching grant for outreach. I recognize that everyone is focused on the here-and-now with COVID-19, but it will eventually pass and the Transition Committee is making plans for our future. We are thinking about focused advertising on segments of the community aligned with our beliefs by being a sponsor at Germantown Community Theater, Powell Community Theater in Collierville, and maybe GPAC (as a stretch goal). Pastor Patti agrees that this is a potentially cost-advantageous way to bring in new visitors.

Now for the part where you come in. Council has identified some areas of the budget that can be used as seed funds, but we need more from the congregation to make the matching grant meaningful. Therefore, I am asking you to either go to the Epiphany website (epiphanylu.org) to make a donation via Paypal or a credit card (make sure you choose Outreach Matching Grant from the dropdown list) or you can write a check (put Outreach in memo) and send it to our mailing address (PO Box 1805, Collierville, TN 38027).

I need to submit the matching grant paperwork by April 14 so time is of the essence. If you do write a check, it would be a good idea to let Lori Crossmock (epiphanytreasurer1@gmail.com) know in case it is in transit when we submit. 
