Growing Our Church Is Like Growing Our Garden

Epiphany's garden is a wonderful site to behold. Our garden crew has put many hours into preparing the soil, planting, building fences to protect produce from forest animals, cutting grass, working on the lawn equipment, and finally picking, drying, and delivering the produce. The crew is a well-oiled machine that invites new people to join them and welcomes them when they show up. Further they make sure that any new garden crew members are trained and don't feel alone in their work. The gardeners have a clear and appealing mission, "to grow food for the hungry."

This model is exactly the same thing that makes a church grow. We know where to find and how to invite new workers to the garden, but I'm not sure we know where to find and how to invite new people to attend Epiphany. Like the gardeners, we need to have a clear, appealing, and succinct mission. We must ask ourselves, "Can I articulate our mission, and when I do is it a mission that gets others excited about Epiphany?" The majority of new members who come to a church do so because an existing member invites them. They invite them whether they are well known or even hardly a friend. Again, like our garden crew who accepts everyone who shows up to work (even the judge's club), we need to think about how we can continually and systematically personally invite people to Epiphany. I say this because I think Epiphany is a unique and special place to worship that others would enjoy if we just got the word out in a personal way. Some churches that are growing quickly, put 10 invitation cards that can be personalized on each pew seat each week and ask people to give them away that week.

Now, we aren't out and about very much right now because of Covid-19, but we can email friends and use our telephones to invite people to zoom in on Sundays. Call someone and then forward them the zoom link and do it more than one time. I have several friends and acquaintances from whom I receive a worship link and life update email every Saturday. Epiphany can grow and be as prolific as our garden, but it is up to each family to realize that sharing the love of Jesus is the priority of any Christian Church.




Reopening Committee Update

Service will continue to be only via Zoom until at least September. Unfortunately, COVID-19 cases are not yet declining in Shelby County as they have been mostly flat for the last 2 weeks. Moreover, a month ago, the daily average case count was only 200, so the risks are even greater now than earlier in the pandemic.

This means that we have not yet reached even Level 1 from the ELCA guidelines which would allow indoor services of up to 10 people. Even if case counts prevent us from returning to the Chapel in September, the weather hopefully will begin cooling and services at Home Place can be reconsidered.

The Epiphany Council wants to keep everyone informed about our financial situation. This month we will take a look at the numbers from June 2020. Epiphany applied for and received a SBA PPP loan of \$12,500 at the end of May. This money will be used for salaries and rent during the pandemic.

Take home a bouquet from the Epiphany Community Garden!


