From the Pastor's Desk

Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end. For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part; but when the complete comes, the partial will come to an end. When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became an adult, I put an end to childish ways. For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love. ~1 Corinthians 13:4-13

February is seen by many to be the season of love. Hearts, candies, flowers, proclamations of love. Signs and symbols of human love are on full display everywhere you look.

It's tempting to become cynical at the obvious commercial forces suggesting to us that there can be no love if there isn't an eye-poppingly expensive display to herald one's love proclamation.

In truth, the reminders to express our love for others is a good reminder. Once a year is inadequate however; we are called to love as God loves—inclusively, completely, without reservation or time limits.

Writers, poets, and preachers are all reminded to show, not tell. So it is with love; following Christ's example, we are to show before we tell or our words ring hollow. To do is to love; vising, feeding, clothing, standing for and with, befriending—there are so many ways to show love, to be love.

The three great spiritual gifts that abide—faith, hope, love—all seem to be passive qualities. They are all actually active in how we are called and gifted to use them. An active faith not only believes, but also acts to bring about the (cont. next page)

ways of God's Kingdom. An active hope not only dreams a future but also actively prepares for it. An active love looks at the world through the eyes of Jesus and sees it filled with life that is loved enough to be saved, then reaches out with human hands to do God's work for the restoration of God's holy will and ways.

These three abide. And the greatest of these is love. Greatest because love is the truest definition we have of God. And in this month we again turn our attention to the greatest gift of love we have been given as we start our Lenten journey.

Epiphany Financial Update

In December, Tithing was 13% below budget continuing a trend over the last several months. Expenses were 5% under budget. For 2022 YTD, Revenue was above budget (by 2%) and Expenses were under budget by 9%. These offset each other so that we were slightly in the black. However, our bank account totals are down due to payments from designated funds. Two families contributed funds to paying down our MIF loan.

Because we seek to honor your generosity and keep administrative costs low, we do not track individual financial gifts to specific families or locations in the U.S. or abroad. More than 85 percent of your gifts directly support our programs. Less than 15 percent is used for administration and fundraising.
