### From the Pastor's Desk

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea; though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble with its tumult. There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. God is in the midst of the city; it shall not be moved; God will help it when the morning dawns. The nations are in an uproar, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts. The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Come, behold the works of the Lord; see what desolation he has brought on the earth. He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; he breaks the bow, and shatters the spear; he burns the shields with fire. Be still, and know that I am God! I am exalted among the nations, I am exalted in the earth." The Lord of hosts is with us;

It seems much of our modern angst is of degrees. The world has always been troubled: there have always been wars, crime, acts of extreme cruelty. There have always been natural disasters. There has always been illness, always political unrest, always poverty, always abuse.





What is new in our present age is the immediacy of everyone finding out, the depth of the coverage, the photos that lay bare all the atrocities. It becomes overwhelming and can easily render us powerless to do anything at all to alleviate suffering, to actually hear any single cry for help in the cacophony of all voices everywhere. All of that combined with the latest technology that kills, maims and destroys so much more powerfully than ever before. The Revolutionary War officer's order "Don't shoot until you see the whites of their eyes," seems quaint and humane when compared to today's warfare involving destruction wrought by unmanned drones raining down destruction on targets unseen and enemies unacknowledged as human beings.

And then there is the great existential threat of climate change. It is no wonder humans across the globe are filled with angst and fear.

How do we respond, as people of God? What can we do to quiet the disquiet are living in?

We have rich resources to remind us of our God who cares, who upholds, who comforts. Look at this Psalm: God is our present help. Not far off, not remote, but here in every time and place. Whatever the circumstances, God is in the thick of things. Is with us. Is our refuge.

How can we possibly live into that promise, that presence? In this New Year, let us begin by going back to basics. Be still and know. Know that God is God. God is exalted among all nations, in the earth. The Lord of hosts is with us.

Be still, and know. There are many spiritual practices that are designed to tap into that stillness and knowledge, and help our head knowledge sink down to become heart knowledge, and from heart knowledge we can reach back our to the world to help carry the love of God into a broken world. If you are interested in exploring spiritual practices in this new year, I am open to leading and teaching some of them. Just let me know how I can help you be still, and know.




# **Synod News**

In the days following George Floyd's murder, the eyes of the world were on the intersection of 38th Street and Chicago Avenue in Minneapolis. The corner where Floyd was killed by police in May 2020 became the epicenter of a passionate local uprising around racial justice, leading to the largest protest movement in American history. One block away from the corner now known as George Floyd Square stood Calvary Lutheran Church, where Shari Seifert, president of the European Descent Lutheran Association for Racial Justice, is a member. ## **Investing in Epiphany Lutheran Church**

### If You Are Over 72

As many of you know, if you have an IRA investment account and you are over 72 you are required to take a minimum distribution from that account each year. What you might not be aware of is that you can make contributions to any charitable organization from this distribution and those contributions are tax exempt. It is excellent way to make a contribution to Epiphany. You should check with your investment advisor and find out how you can take advantage of this benefit.

### At Any Age

If you have an investment portfolio with significant gains, ask your financial advisor about setting up a charitable donor-advised fund. You can transfer stock, mutual funds, etc. directly to it without paying capital gains and that transfer counts as a charitable contribution for your itemized deductions. Many investment companies sponsor donor-advised charitable funds (e.g., Fidelity, Schwab, Vanguard); some banks (such as Bank of America) offer them as well. You can then manage this donor-advised fund to donate to charities (including Epiphany) whenever you want.
