Stewardship Letter from Dan & Vicki Scherf



Dear Members of Epiphany,

When Wally Knight asked the two of us to write a letter to the congregation on stewardship, we considered the request a challenge. A challenge to put our ideas about faith and stewardship down on paper. A challenge to stir and inspire the congregation about Epiphany's mission. Here goes.

As we near the end of the year, many of us think about stewardship and giving, even though we may or may not be comfortable with those subjects. We looked at stewardship both in terms of what we've been given and what we can give to others. Despite some personal challenges this year, we feel extraordinarily blessed with the love of family and friends, with reasonably good health, and with the abundance of God's grace in our lives. We have enough to eat, enough money to cover our needs and wants, enough left over to share with others.

This leads nicely into our second thought about stewardship – giving to others. When we pondered whether to increase our gift to Epiphany, we thought about what our increased gift could do. In-person worship services continue to be offered via Zoom for those who are unable or unwilling to attend worship in person. Holy Communion is offered at all in-person worship services. MASK GUIDELINES: Shelby County instituted a mandatory mask mandate on August 20th. It requires masks in all indoor public settings for people over the age of 2, regardless of vaccination status. 
Epiphany Financial Update

Epiphany Fall Festival at the Garden


Epiphany will be hosting our fall festival on Saturday, November 6, 2021 at 3:30 pm at the Community | Garden at Home Place!




Collierville Happenings


