



## **January 2019 Council Summary Report**

President, Carol Rife, called the council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Kingsway library. All members were present except Pastor Monica Weber who was away for a Spiritual Director's seminar. The newly elected council members were also present. A quorum was established.

#### Business requiring a vote of the council:

- Council voted to donate a laptop to Collierville Connected Resource Center which has been on loan to them.
- Council voted to pay the balance of \$430.10 on the copier which Collierville Connection has been using. Once the transaction is complete the copier will be donated to the Collierville Connection.
- Council voted to pay the \$250.00 dues for continued membership in the Collierville Chamber of Commerce. What Epiphany has received from its membership with support from Collierville Youth Leadership working in the garden in March warrants our renewed membership.

The South East Synod Assembly will convene May 31st through June 2nd. Epiphany can send two delegates which could be a husband/wife team. February registration is required. More details to come.

#### **New Business:**

Council decided on new council officers and team leaders. Phil Goetz will serve as council President, Martha Garner will remain as Vice President and Fellowship, Lori Crossmock will remain as Treasurer, Dan Scherf as Financial Secretary, Andria Prouty will become the new Council Secretary and will help with Christian Ed. and Evangelism/Outreach, Chris Kelyman will continue with Stewardship and T-2, Jennifer Parker for Evangelism, Wally Knight will oversee Property, Ed Schumacher will continue with Long Range planning and Pastor will oversee Worship and Music. Connected Resource Center (CCRC) - Epiphany is a coalition partner church with the Collierville Connected Resource Center which provides job skills training such as basic computer operation, resume assistance, help with job applications and interview skills, and offers job search tips for unemployed persons. Without at least two volunteers present, the Center cannot open due to Safe Church practices. If you have an hour to spare, CCRC could use your help. Hours are Tuesdays, 9 - 11:30 am and 4 - 7 pm; Thursdays 9 - 11:30 am; Saturdays 9 -11:30 am. A one-hour light training session is provided. The CCRC is located in the basement of Sanctuary on the Square, 104 N. Rowlett St., Collierville. See Pastor Monica to volunteer or for more information.
