The time after Epiphany can be a time to connect with neighbors even if only by phoner and to meet "Christ in mouth of friend and stranger." If you talk to people this season a be sure to collect prayer requests from everyone – family and friends alike. These prayer requests can form the basis for your prayer list and prayer life and if appropriate be added to the church intercessory prayers throughout the season.

## 12/20/20 Congregational Meeting Summary

Thank you to everyone who attended the congregational meeting! Here are the results of our ballot measures - all measures passed.

- Electing Twila Hooverson to Council (33 approve; 0 oppose)
- Electing Becca Schumacher to Council (33 approve; 0 oppose)
- Moving Worship to [Collierville Presbyterian Church](#) effective Feb. 1, 2021 (33 approve; 0 oppose) - **Please note that although February 1 is the agreement start date, we may not begin in-person worship then due to COVID restrictions/concerns.**
- Reducing Pastor's hours to 4 days/week (32 approve; 1 oppose)
- Overall Interim 2021 Budget (33 approve; 0 oppose)
- Constitution and By-Law changes (33 approve; 0 oppose)

## Epiphany Financial Update

The Epiphany Council wants to keep everyone informed about our financial situation. This month we will take a look at the numbers from November 2020. Epiphany applied for and received a SBA PPP loan of \$12,500 at the end of May. This money will be used for salaries and rent during the pandemic. The PPP loan is included in our revenue.

The November numbers were better than the projected November budget deficit by \$2,647.66

The YTD numbers are less than the projected 2020 budget deficit by \$20,174.22. (This number includes the SBA PPP loan of \$12,500.)

Happy Advent 2020!

What a year! Challenges. Opportunities. In and through it all ...a child is given... Emmanuel - God is with us! So, we always have HOPE!

The words "Thank You" seem too minimal for all you have done to support me through the years and all you are doing now:

I thank you for embracing me and my family during the hardest, yet most grace-filled, journey we will ever undertake – the death of our beloved Erin – my baby girl; Dana's only sister; Michael's baby sister; Brian's worrisome older sister. Auntie to Chris, Johnathon, Luna Jada, Zoey, and Kynnedi. Mom to her furries Teddy (aka 'The Tedster') and Smokey. The day will come when I will be able to properly send "Thank You" notes to all who joined us that day early December 2018 when we celebrated her life and then Pastor Monica commended Erin to God. That day, and frankly many others, is still a big blur. And, I have yet to open that lovely wicker basket containing cards and well-wishes from you and many other friends. Some day, I will.

I thank you for welcoming me back after literally disappearing for two years after Erin's death. I did not respond to your calls. I did not respond to your cards. I did not respond to Pastor Monica's attempts to comfort me. I needed to grieve as I needed to grieve. And, I thank you for allowing me to do that and then making me welcome when I was ready to come out of my cave.

I am truly grateful for your support of my ministry – beginning with support for my candidacy. I am truly humbled by the outpouring of your support for God's Work Our Hands at Peace when MANY of you showed up with rolled up sleeves and lots of supplies to pressure wash, dig flowerbeds, plant flowerbeds, fill empty planters – all the while wearing face coverings and social distancing. Thelma and Louise are phenomenal women!

I thank you for your financial support to help with the purchase of vestments. Your gift covered a substantial portion of the cost for 2 shirts and a robe. Frankly, I was a bit stressed when Pastor Jill informed me it was time to wear the collar. Long story.

I, and the people of Peace, thank you for the Christmas gifts allowing our congregation to provide toys and gifts to 83 children (the largest number, to date!). We thank you for your donation of food in support of the Monday-Wednesday lunch. Thanks for the donation of computers and printer - for the technical help to set the computers up! The computers allow us to gather virtually for worship and fellowship via Zoom.

I am grateful for your support of the ministry of Chosen Vessel Ministries. Thank you for sending cards and letters to the women incarcerated in Henning. Contact with the free world means a lot to the women. They really appreciate receiving mail – and, they are especially appreciative when that mail comes from a stranger. I am thrilled that three of the women in our re-entry planning group have been released on parole. Please keep them in your prayers.

Pastor TroyAnn and friends at Epiphany, this "Thank You" is minimal and long overdue. Please excuse me for that. I do want you to know I feel words are inadequate to express a gratitude that is coming from such a deep deep place. I have so much to be thankful for. In addition to all I write, I am most grateful for your prayers and love. And, yes, I have been crying since I started writing this note. Pastor TroyAnn, your kind note and spirit-filled suggestions to me during a really challenging time a few weeks ago are appreciated and very helpful. Thank you!

I end by asking you to continue praying for me, my family, Chosen Vessel Ministries, the community of faith known as Peace, and all God entrusts to our care and love. We will continue in prayer for you, Pastor TroyAnn, and the family of Epiphany Lutheran Church.
