Where is God....

Have you ever asked "Where is God?" It's tempting to ask this question as we watch the news, confronted with daily reports of tragedy, violence and hatred. Yet God is with us: on Pentecost, we celebrate Jesus' sending of the Holy Spirit to be our constant Advocate, Comforter and Guide. The Spirit of God reminds us of God's constant presence in our lives, accompanying us through the events of a world mired in sin. The holy fire of the Spirit that we receive in the sacrament of baptism lives within us forever, and by the Spirit we are never separated from God, or God's unconditional love. The Spirit is at work in ways



we may not always notice: by Pentecost our Synod will celebrate the election of a new bishop, the result of the Spirit leading our Assembly to raise up the right person. In mid-June, I will gather with pastor colleagues at Lutheran Theological Seminary of the South for a continuing education Spiritual Direction intensive. What I learn in these long days of study is invigorating, insightful and useful, but the Spirit-filled conversations that emerge are what deeply connect us and empower us as Christians who live as the universal Body of Christ.

It can be difficult to notice the Spirit at work when we can't always see it, but Jesus tells us in John 3:8 that the wind of the Spirit blows as it pleases—God's Holy Spirit can never be restricted, and will always do God's will. God's constant Advocate and Comforter, the Holy Spirit, is alive within you. Trust the Spirit, and follow its lead whenever you wonder where God is, because it will always redirect your path back to the God of all grace.

For gardeners, May 4th was a "beautiful day at the garden!" The Bee House Build was successful, and the rain held off until nearly 11 am. Our Master Gardener friend, Carl Wayne Hardeman, attended and took a garden tour, and was happy to receive a bee house. He is interested in purchasing a few more and offered to pay \$20 per house. Also, Val Tingly visited, made a bee house and toured the garden. She's also a Master Gardener and works on a team at the Victory Garden located at the Christian Church on Byhalia.

Work in the garden continues! Our friend Val Tingly of the Collierville Victory Garden contributed excess plants (65 tomatoes, peppers, egg plants and cantaloupe) that they received from a nursery on Sladen, MS. We're excited about this perfect gift and most grateful for this contribution! We planted them on May 25th in various beds in Section A&B. That same day, we planted additional pole beans, weeded and planted sunflower seeds by the back fence. We also fed the worm pods, which appear to be thriving!

We had a new volunteer as well - Anu, a rising senior at Collierville High School. We look forward to seeing him in the garden in the next few weeks before he and his family leave Collierville.
