Room In The Inn (RITI)

Four volunteers are needed to pick up sheets and towels on the third Tuesday every month through March 2020 to launder and return to Kingsway by the following Sunday - the last date for the spring is March 17. If you have never participated in RITI, you will find it to be a most meaningful experience as a volunteer. Sign up to help here!

Collierville Connected Resource Center (CCRC) - Epiphany is a coalition partner church with the Collierville Connected Resource Center which provides job skills training such as basic computer operation, resume assistance, help with job applications and interview skills, and offers job search tips for unemployed persons. Without at least two volunteers present, the Center cannot open due to Safe Church practices. If you have an hour to spare, CCRC could use your help. Hours are Tuesdays, 9 - 11:30 am and 4 - 7 pm; Thursdays 9 - 11:30 am; Saturdays 9 -11:30 am. A one-hour light training session is provided. The CCRC is located in the basement of Sanctuary on the Square, 104 N. Rowlett St., Collierville. See Pastor Monica to volunteer or for more information.










Wednesday Night Lenten Fellowship & Study
