Epiphany Financial Update

The Epiphany Council wants to keep everyone informed about our financial situation. The data below do not include designated funds. We did very well in January with both Revenue and Expenses. Tithing was higher than budgeted primarily because one family gave extra as catch-up for 2020. Expenses were less than budgeted due to our continuing to only paying interest on our Home Place mortgage, not paying full rent while we are worshiping by Zoom, and other activities being curtailed by pandemic restrictions.

- The 2020 Epiphany Annual Report was accepted by voice vote.
- The revised 2021 Epiphany budget was unanimously approved by ballot vote.
- The Constitution and By-laws changes/ratifications were unanimously approved by ballot vote.
- The following Call Committee members were unanimously approved by ballot vote: John Kelyman, Anil Lankapalli, Carol Rife, and Vicki Scherf.

March 2021 Prayers




Every month, the ELCA provides its Prayer Ventures for member congregations. The link to the monthly prayers can always be found on our website on the Christian


Make it a family affair!


