#### **Easter, Ascension, Trinity Sunday and Pentecost**

We're in the midst of a busy 50 days on the Christian Calendar. We had Holy Week followed by the Crucifixion and the Resurrection. Christ then spends 40 days on earth walking amongst his disciples, showing his resurrection body, eating with them, teaching, praying, and encouraging him. That is the Easter Season we are in right now. Celebrating the presence of the resurrected Christ as he walked the earth and showed evidence of rising from the dead. We want to celebrate this Easter season and be as thrilled by it as the disciples were to see him again and here him encourage them.

On the 40th day after the resurrection, Christ much to his disciple's chagrin ascended into heaven. They felt

lost, abandoned, and still could not understand his full mission. He had come to teach, preach, heal, and share the love of God with them and the people of Israel. They did not understand that he had to leave for the Holy Spirit to come to every believer and give them the same powers and understanding of God's love that Christ himself had. They again waited alone in sadness and confusion not fully understanding God's plan. Christ had told them the plan that they would receive power from on high but as usual, the ways of God are hard to decipher if our own preconceived ideas or feelings overlay them. They waited 10 more days for a total of 50 days after the Resurrection until the Jewish Harvest Festival of Shavuot and then the Holy Spirit descended upon all of them filling the void that Christ had left. The Spirit provided all the love, the knowledge, the power, and sense of fellowship that they had with Christ. In fact, because the Spirit was not limited by either time or space and could be with each individual Christian all at one time, It more than filled the void that they had.

Christ showed what an unseeable, unknowable God was like when he came to earth as a God-Man. Jesus was also willing to show us obedience and was willing to die for us and all the rest of the world. He gave us saving grace when we believe in him, and the Holy Spirit continues in us to nurture mature, teach and guide us now. *Enjoy and celebrate all these 50 days of the Easter season until we get to Pentecost on May 23rd. Then be prepared to wear red to church as we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit.*
