Guided by the work of a core team of women leaders, in May 2019 all Region 9 bishops gathered to begin work on a "Bishops' Relational Agreement for Candidacy, Call Process, and Boundaries." We are thankful that in July 2019 this agreement was adopted and we are eager to share it now with leaders throughout the region. ### The Epiphany Community Garden continues to produce!

NOTE: Wednesday community workday hours are now 9 am - 11 am; Saturdays are as needed.

October was a busy month! At the beginning of the month it was still hot and dry, and we worked up a number of beds and planted turnip and mustard seed tapes, as well as watered all the new seed beds and cucumber cages. The cucumber plants were flowering like crazy, and produced more than 6 pounds of cucumbers to pick on October 2nd! With the weather hopefully cooling soon, we expect to see more production from our tomato plants.

We finally saw significant rain the middle of the month - with more than 2.5" showing in the garden rain gauge. On 10/12, we harvested various vegetables and fertilized the tomato plants.

October 16 was a beautiful day at the garden - as Wendell says, "cool and clear as a bell!" With the cooler temperatures, we are seeing more tomatoes, and removed dead plant material from them, as well as did some weeding throughout the garden. Cucumber production remains steady, and we harvested 57 pounds of vegetables. We see evidence of some "munching" on the greens - our deer friends are probably the culprits.

We had another beautiful day at the garden on October 23rd! We weeded, removed and stored the irrigation system, finished the shelf installation in the tool shed, performed maintenance on the push mower and did some mowing and general cleaning up. We gathered 35 pounds of greens, cucumbers, tomatoes, okra and peppers, for a total this season so far of 1,069 pounds!

More rain at the garden on 10/25 - the rain gauge showed another 3/4" with more rain on the way.
