Stewardship Campaign Begins October 13

Dear Friends in Christ,

It is hard to believe but it is time to launch Epiphany's fall Stewardship Campaign. Beginning on Sunday, October 13 through Sunday, November 10, a council member will give a brief temple talk on a Stewardship Principle and how their chosen verse speaks to them. Ed Schumacher will launch the campaign on Sunday, October 13, with his thoughts on "Respond Gratefully." This will be followed on consecutive Sundays by Lori Crossmock with "Sacrifice Proportionately," Jennifer Parker with "Give Willingly," Martha Garner with "Share Abundantly" and Phil Goetz, our Council President, concluding the Stewardship series with "Accept a Challenge."



At the end of the five week series on November 10 we will congregate after the service in the Kingsway Fellowship Hall to share a potluck meal and to celebrate the Abundance God has blessed us with individually and as a congregation and community of believers. During the celebration event a brief "state of the union" update will be given, 2020 pledge cards will be distributed with the stewardship principles printed on them as guides for us to use to live into God's promises and abundance. New offering envelopes and Time and Talent sheets will also be distributed.

May the five week Stewardship Campaign provide an opportunity for us to reflect on the abundance of gifts God has blessed Epiphany with knowing that God will continue to bless Epiphany as we move into the future. We have been blessed with interim Pastor TroyAnn Poulopoulos who will lead us through the discernment process of where God is leading Epiphany, we are blessed with children in the congregation, a seminary student, faithful garden angels who manage our community garden, volunteers for Room in the Inn and Pastor Tony's ministry and we are blessed with one another. Let us use the five-week Stewardship Campaign to renew our commitment to "God's Work, Our Hands" through the wise use of our time, talents and financial resources all to the Glory of God and his Kingdom.



1,000 pounds and counting!

September was a busy month at the Community Garden! In early September, the garden angels weeded and watered various areas, dusted the squash and cucumber plants, mowed despite facing mechanical issues, and harvested butternut squash, tomatoes, peppers, okra and a watermelon.

Mid-September saw more mowing (with the dry weather, the grass is thankfully not growing quite as fast!), did some equipment maintenance, weeded, tilled and cleaned up trash, watered, and planted some turnip and mustard seed tapes. The harvest for Collierville Food Pantry included okra, tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, eggplant and a watermelon!

Toward the end of the month, we had some nice weather on our work days - not as hot as it had been! We installed a wire perimeter fence around the cucumber cages - so many yellow flowers on the vines mean lots of cucumbers to come! We also cleaned up some of the tomato beds, weeded and planted a few more turnip seed tapes. This season through September, we have harvested close to 1,000 pounds of vegetables, including the last delivery of various vegetables and turnip greens. Thanks to all the garden crew who make this magic happen.
