The **Early College Arc** is designed to enable Scholars to complete the bulk of their High School requirements by the end of their tenth grade year. This highly competitive Early College Arc provides Scholars with the opportunity to take multiple AP and College Now courses during their 11th & 12th grade years. Scholars that qualify for this Arc must earn 6 credits during 8th grade with 3 Regents exams passed, a minimum of 17 credits after their 9th grade year, and then 30 credits after their 10th grade year. Entering the 11th grade, Early College Arc Scholars must have successfully passed a minimum of 8 Regents exams. To remain in the program, Scholars must earn at least a 75% + on their Math and English Regents exams. Scholars must also maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above (80%). Full participation in a PSAL sport or Extended Learning Opportunity is mandatory for this Arc.
