

Academic Expectations	<b>How will scholars be graded?</b>	Scholars will be graded with the same expectations we have always held as an Eagle school. Scholars are expected to continue to put full Effort into all assignments, show Confidence by asking questions when they are confused, and show Commitment to Excellence by completing all work on time.
Academic Expectations	<b>Will all assignments need to be submitted electronically?</b>	Just like in the Spring, the vast majority of assignments will be submitted through Google Classroom.
Academic Expectations	<b>My scholar is struggling in a class. How can he get additional assistance?</b>	All educators are holding daily virtual office hours. Scholars are strongly encouraged to take the initiative and logon for these office hours if they are struggling. The schedule of all educator's office hours is forthcoming.
Blended Learning	<b>When will I know which days my scholar will be coming into the building?</b>	We have already sent out the days scholars will be attending in the building. If you did not receive this or have any questions, please email Mrs. Bringley at tbringley@eagleacademybk.org.

Blended Learning	<b>I have more than one child attending Eagle. Will they attend in-person on the same days?</b>	Yes.
Blended Learning	<b>What supplies should my scholar bring with him to school?</b>	You scholar must come to school every day with his own: 1. pencils/pens, 2. pencil sharpener, 3. ruler, 4. notebooks, 5. books, 6. chromebook OR tablet with keyboard, 7. calculator (Grades 6-7: 4-function; 8-12: TI 84), 8. water bottle(s), and 9. snack.
Blended Learning	<b>My scholar is only coming in 2 days a week. I need childcare for my scholar on his remote days. Communication	<b>Will parents have the ability to come to the building for meetings with educators?</b>	In-person meetings will be granted on an extremely limited basis. The vast majority of meetings will take place via video conference.
Extracurriculars	<b>Will there be sports (PSAL or otherwise) this fall?</b>	As of now, there are NO PSAL sports.
Extracurriculars	<b>Will there be Extended Day this fall?</b>	There will be NO Extended Day in the fall.
Health & Safety	<b>Do I need to get my son tested for COVID before school starts?</b>	The DOE is not requiring that students get tested before returning to school. However, you are welcome to get your son tested for your own peace of mind.
Health & Safety	<b>If a scholar comes in with a high fever is there a room set up to isolate the scholar while waiting to be picked up?</b>	Yes. Eagle has an "isolation room" for any scholar showing signs of illness. Scholars will wait in the isolation room until a family member can come pick them up.
Health & Safety	<b>My scholar has a cold / cough / diarrhea but no fever. Should I send him to school?</b>	If a student or teacher is feeling sick, they are required to stay home and, if their symptoms are consistent with COVID-19, are asked to get tested.
Health & Safety	<b>Wearing a mask for 5 hours straight is not healthy or realistic for my child. Will he be able to take off his mask at any time during the day?</b>	We have built time into the hybrid schedule to address these concerns. Scholars will have staggered times to take off masks for a few minutes while continuing to socially distance.
Health & Safety	<b>Sitting in the same classroom for 5 hours straight is not healthy or realistic for my child. Will he be able to move around / have any exercise or movement time?</b>	We have built time into the hybrid schedule to address these concerns. Scholars will have staggered times to stretch.
Health & Safety	<b>Will Eagle provide face masks?</b>	The DOE has promised to provide all schools with face masks. We will distribute those for free. We have also purchased some special edition Eagle masks and face wraps with our logo, which will be on sale for \$10 each.
Health & Safety	<b>What happens if someone tests positive</b>	All scholars and educators from that person's Nest will be required to quarantine for 14 days and attend class virtually. If 2

or more people in a building (that includes individuals from the 2 schools co-located in our building) test positive within a 7-day period, the entire building will be required to go all-remote for an unspecified period of time.

Health & Safety	<b>Will the school community be notified if someone in the school has tested positive?</b>	Yes. This is why it is extremely important that we have accurate and updated contact information for every parent. This includes phone numbers and emails.
Remote Instruction	<b>How do I opt into 100% Remote Instruction?</b>	If you would like to opt into 100% Remote Instruction, please email Mrs. Bringley at tbringley@eagleacademybk.org.
Remote Instruction	<b>What if I opt-in to remote instruction, but then change my mind and want my scholar to come into the building?</b>	If you complete the form opting into 100% remote instruction, you will NOT be able to opt back in until the end of October.
Seniors	<b>What is the plan for graduation 2021?</b>	We hope Graduation 2021 can be live and in person. However, we have no way of knowing what our health and safety situation will be in the Spring. Given the circumstances, we cannot yet make any plans for graduation.
Seniors	<b>If my Senior scholar needs to make up credits in order to graduate in June, when during remote learning will he be able to make up those credits?</b>	The transcripts of all Seniors will be reviewed to determine if additional remote courses will be necessary to get Seniors on track for graduation.
Seniors	<b>Will seniors still have to stay for all 4 cores if they don't necessarily need them?</b>	Yes, all seniors must take one of each of the 4 cores (Math, Science, ELA, History) even if they have fulfilled their city requirements already. It is important that colleges see that our scholars are not just doing the minimum to coast through their Senior Year.
Technology	<b>What technology will my scholar need?</b>	<a href="#">Every scholar needs either a laptop (such as a Chromebook) OR a tablet with a keyboard.</a> They need this both for in-person and remote learning. If you require a tablet, you can still request one from the DOE: <a href="https://coronavirus.schools.nyc/remoteteachingdevices">https://coronavirus.schools.nyc/remoteteachingdevices</a> .
Technology	<b>Does my scholar need a calculator?</b>	<a href="#">Scholars in grades 6 and 7 need a 4-function calculator. Scholars in grades 8-12 need a TI 84 Graphic Calculator. Uniform	<b>What are the uniform expectations for in-person learning?</b>	Scholars should wear a blue oxford shirt, gray pants and their grade-appropriate tie. These will be for sale at the start of the year. Scholars will be able to safely purchase these beginning the first day of school during their class period.
Uniform	<b>What are the uniform expectations for remote learning?</b>	During Remote Learning, scholars are expected to wear an Eagle tshirt.
Uniform	<b>When will I be able to purchase uniform items?</b>	Scholars will be able to purchase their grade-appropriate tie and Eagle t-shirts during the first week of school. All other uniform items can be purchased at most stores.
Uniform	<b>Will there be an option to purchase ties or tshirts online?</b>	We are currently working to ensure we are able to sell tshirts and ties in the safest way possible. We are exploring all options and will have an answer for you towards the end of August.
