Real Connections


The HOW and WHY:

Senior Flight Plan: Implementation

Cross-Curricular

- Credit bearing classes incorporate projects, assignments and other work related to each component.
- Opportunities are available more than once during a semester.
- □ All opportunities are clearly specified in course syllabus, engrade and students receive reminders.

Workshops & Independent Opps

- □ Departments, educators and admin will provide different opportunities for students to explore and execute components.
- □ Workshops/Independent Opps will be offered throughout the year, be clearly visible, tracked and students will receive reminders.

Senior Flight Plan: Accountability

Student & Parent

- □ Completion of the SFP is a clearly stated expectation/mandate. Parents and students will receive SFP details, timeline and expectations early in the year.
- Parents will receive phone blast and communications about scholar's SFP status.

Educator & Administration

- □ Educators include SFP as part of the narrative in phone calls, PTC and written materials home.
- ☐ Counselors include SFP in their dialogue during student check-ins.
- □ Reminders are provided during Town Hall, Parent/Senior Workshops, Ujima and etc.
- □ Letters/notices are sent home 2-3 times a year with strong language.
