

Two Color Brioche

Two-Color Brioche is one of those techniques that looks wildly complex but clicks once you understand the rhythm. In this class, we'll break it down step by step so you can confidently work brioche knit and purl stitches, manage two colors, and actually read your work instead of guessing your way through it. You'll leave with a strong foundation, practical troubleshooting skills, and a free pattern to keep building your confidence after class.
