

Learn to spin using a Turkish Spindle

The Turkish Spindle is a historic, bottom whorl suspended spindle originating from the Middle Eastern and Anatolian Peninsula. Known for its unique cross-arm design, it creates a stable, efficient spinning tool that produces a self-contained, center-pull ball of yarn, allowing it to be easily dismantled for portability. You will learn how to spin fiber on a Turkish Spindle, then learn how to single ply into a turtle ball. You will then learn the art of 2-plying your single ply using the same spindle. The Spindle is yours to take home with you. Fiber for this class will be provided.
