

Introduction to Intarsia

Intarsia is a knitting technique that uses separate lengths of yarn for each color in a row or round. In this class, we will create a series of swatches using intarsia, and discuss the many ways this knowledge can benefit your work (even when you're not working in multiple colors)! You'll leave the class with a better understanding of the process, along with a swatch demonstrating each technique.

BEGINNER CLASS

basic knitting skills required

Basic knitting supplies needed:

4-5 partial skeins of different colors of yarn, all worsted weight, circular knitting needles appropriate for the yarn you have selected (I like to have a variety of needles with me), stitch markers, pencil, stick ruler, sticky notes or magnetic board to keep your place on the chart, and the usual knitting bag filled with treasures.

HOMEWORK:

Be sure all yarns are wound and ready to use.
