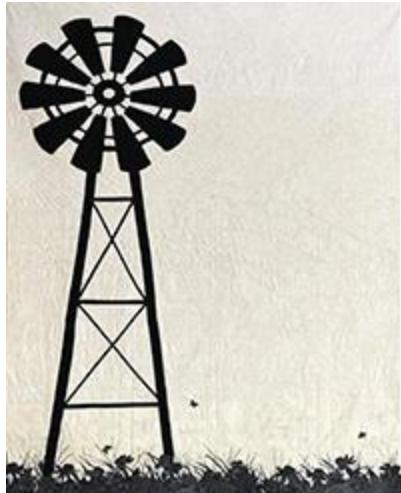


Wide Open Spaces

Technique - Traditional Piecing, Raw-Edge Applique, Flanged/Pipe Binding

Skill Level - Beginner

Finished Project Size: Throw Quilt 42" x 60"

Wide Open Spaces is a minimalistic large-scale applique quilt that feels right at home in Modern Farmhouse decorating. This quilt is made with minimal traditional piecing and large easy applique, making it beginner-friendly and easily mastered in a ½ day class. This quilt comes with several colorway options, so every maker can find the one that fits with his or her design aesthetic.

Class Registration: \$69

Supplies Needed for Class:

- Wide Open Spaces Pattern
- 3/8 yard each of 5 background fabrics
- 1 yard for applique and part of the binding
- 1/4 - 1/3 yard for vegetation applique long bottom of the quilt
- 3 yards of fusible (18" wide) [preferred fusible Hot Fix. Steam-A-Seam Lite II also works. Other fusibles can be hard to use in this project due to the scale of the Applique
- Applique Pressing Sheet or parchment paper
- A permanent marker for marking applique onto fusible paper
- 1 – 12" x 18" quilt (please make this ahead)
- Flange part of binding – [2] 1 3/4" x WOF Strips
- Outside part of binding – [2] 1 1/4" x WOF Strips
- A small ruler with 3/8" marking
- A heat-erasable or chalk marking pen
- 80 – 100 weight cottonized-polyester thread for applique in a color that matches the applique pieces
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)
