Technique - Cutting and accurately piecing with AccuQuilt dies, Traditional piecing with multiple size pieces, Raw-Edge Applique

Skill Level - Intermediate

Finished Project Size: 76"x76"

Vintage Summer Picnic Medallion Quilt is constructed using traditional piecing from pieces cut with AccuQuilt dies. This whimsically vintage quilt can be cut quickly and accurately without foundation papers to make a striking quilt your family will cherish for generations to come. I will

give you all my tips and tricks as a AccuQuilt Designer to get a stunning and flawless result when using AccuQuilt to cut your quilts. My go-to picnic dish recipe (Nanny Roy's fried chicken with Gutherie's sauce) is included in the pattern.

Fabric:

- 1 3/4 yards of dark blue
- 1/2 yard of medium blue
- 3 yards of white
- 2 yards of pale yellow background
- 1/8 yard of medium yellow
- 1 yard of bright yellow
- 1/2 yard of light pink
- 1 yard of medium pink
- 1 yard of red
- 1 yard of lime green
- 3/4 yard of bright green
- 5/8 yard of orange
- 1/8 yard of dusk orange
- 1 yard of fusible (12" wide) [preferred fusible Hot Fix]
- Applique Pressing Sheet or parchment paper
- Roxann's Glue Baste
- 80-100 weight cottonized-polyester thread for applique in a color that matches the applique pieces
- 1 yard of Fusible batting
- Lightbox (optional)

Supplies Needed for Class:

- Vintage Picnic Pattern
- Dies for cutting pieces (Available in class for purchase or use)
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)
