Technique - Traditional Piecing with Large Pieces, Applique (Raw-edge or Turned-edge)

Skill Level - Beginner

Finished Project Size: Throw Quilt 56" x 72" (can be lengthened to Twin)

Mid Mod Noel is a modern quilt with a vintage mid-century vibe. It combines the traditional Christmas colors with pastels and minimalistic design to illicit a feeling of nostalgia and a flood of whimsical holiday memories. This quilt's construction uses large pieces and beginner friendly piecing. For anyone who is currently a piecer but curious about trying applique this quilt is a wonderful introduction into the discipline of applique.

Class Registration: \$69

Fabric:

- 2 5/8-yard background [model is made in light blush pink]
- 1-yard large candy cane stripe
- 1/2 yard small candy cane stripe [for top poinsettia block and wreath's bow]
- 1 1/4 yard of white for letters
- Assorted greens totaling 3/8 yard [for holly and mistletoe leaves [holly=bright and lime greens; mistletoe=bluish, sage and gray greens]
- Assorted whites totaling 1/4 yard [mistletoe berries]
- Assorted reds totaling 1/4 yard [holly berries]
- 3 yards of fusible (12" wide) [preferred fusible Hot Fix] For Raw-Edge Applique

Supplies Needed for Class:

- Mid Mod Noel Pattern
- Freezer paper templates, starch, paint brush for starch, blotter, and mini-iron for Turned-Edge Applique
- Applique Pressing Sheet or parchment paper
- A permanent marker for making applique onto fusible paper
- A heat-erasable or chalk marking pen
- 80 - 100 weight cottonized-polyester thread for applique in a color that matches the applique pieces
- Basic Sewing Supplies (straight pins and pin cushion, scissors, seam ripper, fabric marking pen or pencil, small cutting mat (no larger than 12x18), and a rotary cutter)
