Arbuckle Summer High Point Champion Award

Awarded to one Adult, one Junior & one horse or pony with the most points earned in all classes (WPCSA, Celebration, & Open).

OFFICIAL RULES and Regulations

All participants showing in WPSCA classes will follow the General Rules and Show Rules for the WPCSA

- **1.** A negative Coggins certificate or copy dated within one year of the show is required for ALL Horses & Ponies. Bring Coggins certificate or a copy to the office at check in.
- **2. Measurement:** All Halter animals 6 years and over, and all performance animals must present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during current competition year, or be measured. Measurements to occur: 7:30 am each day of show or by appointment. Non WPCSA members must pay a \$5 non member measurement fee.
- **3. Payment of Fees:** Only cash, check or Money Orders payable in US Currency will be accepted. Fees must be paid in full with paper work and signatures complete **before numbers will be issued**. You can include an open check with your entries or pay the day of the show. Please make checks payable to Johnson Performance Horses or JPH. Returned checks will be subject to a \$25 fee and must be cleared within 30 days of the last day of the show. **Post entry fee is \$25 per pony. Refund Policy:** No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled, or upon presentation of a Vet Certificate/Doctor's note and <u>notification to the Show Secretary before the start of the show</u>. The Show Committee's discretion will be used in other instances. Decisions of Show Management are final.
- **4. Exhibitors, parents and/or guardians of minor exhibitors** shall indemnify and hold harmless Johnson Performance Horses, show sponsors, employees and/or all horse show officials and employees or volunteers from any and all liability resulting in injury and/or loss sustained by any person, child or ward of such parent/guardian, in any manner occasioned. Be sure to sign the release of liability attached to your entry form.
- **5. Ribbons**: Ribbons for 1-6th place will be given in all classes. Champion and Reserve Champion in all divisions will receive rosettes. Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion will receive a neck sash.
- **6. * Prize Money:** Prize money will be awarded in all STAKES classes. \$30 will be award in each STAKES class. \$30 will be presented to the 1st place winner of each STAKES class with 3 or more entries. STAKES classes with 6 or more entries will also be awarded \$10 to 2nd place. WPCSA Ridden Welsh Championship and WPCSA Adult W/T Equitation will be awarded \$50 to 1st place winner with three or more entries. Total prize money is \$640.

- **8. Driving:** For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle or leaving an animal unattended while hitched; anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.
- 9. All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds must wear protective headgear. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. NOTE: Protective headgear is advised and welcome in all classes of any age group, with no judging penalties.
- 10. All dogs must be on a leash or secured at all times.
- 11. ANY abuse toward any animal or Show Official/Staff will be cause for immediate ejection from the show and premises, WITHOUT REFUND.
- **12.** Management reserves unto itself the right to refuse or cancel any entries, disqualify riders, drivers or exhibitors without incurring claim for damages. Classes will be split where entries warrant. Decisions of the Show Management are final.
- **13. Two (2) Minute Gate Rule:** To be strictly enforced. Additional three (3) minutes will be allowed for <u>requested tack change.</u> The Gate will not be held for more than five (5) minutes
- 14. RV Parking is available through Hardy Murphy Coliseum. Please contact them for price.
- **15.** There will be a concession stand on the grounds.
- 16. Late Fee: A \$25.00 late fee will be assessed for any original entry turned in after June 19, 2020.
- 17. All WPCSA and Gypsy halter classes will be split if entries warrant.

IMPORTANT:

• Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds

Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.



Class Specifications for Gypsy Classes:

Halter

Classes will be judged 60% on type and conformation, 20% on movement, 10% on temperament and 10% on Presence. Excessive unruly behavior or bad temperament shall be penalized.

Get of Sire and Produce of Dam

Get of Sire and Produce of Dam classes will be judged 75% conformation, quality, and breed type and 25% on uniformity of offspring.

Grooming and Conditioning

Grooming & Conditioning Classes will be judged 40% on conditioning, 40% on grooming, 10% on temperament and 10% on Presence.

Showmanship

Judging is based on the exhibitor's showmanship skills , - 20% on leading, 20% on showing, 20% on poise, attitude and presentation, 15% on horse's conditioning, 15% on horse's grooming, 10% on appointments.

Color Classes

Color classes will be judged on richness, balance and clarity of color and crispness of pattern. Horses are to be judged 80% on the natural color of the horse and conformation to count 20%.

North American Bred

To be judged 60% on type and conformation, 20% on movement, 10% on temperament and 10% on Presence.

Dressage Suitability In Hand

Judging will be based on 60% movement, 30% conformation, and 10% general impression. This includes harmony (relationship of conformation to movement) athleticism (strength and mobility) development related to age and condition. Demonstrated character, presence and temperament necessary for dressage training.

English Pleasure

Open to all riders, horse to be shown at a walk, trot and canter (walk/trot division not to canter) both ways of the ring, with light contact, without undue restraint. To be judged 65% performance with emphasis on manners; 25% conformation and movement; 10% appointments. No martingales or tiedowns allowed. Proper english tack and attire required.

English Equitation

Open to all riders to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal & rider and suitability of animal to rider. Tests or pattern may be required and will be posted 1 hour before class.

Pleasure Driving

To be judged: 70% on performance, manners and way of going of the horse(s). 20% on the condition and fit of harness and vehicle. 10% on neatness of attire.

Pleasure Driving Reinsmanship

A pleasure driving class in which entries are judged primarily on the ability and skill of the driver. To be shown at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. Shall be required to rein back. Drivers chosen for a work off may be worked at any gait requested by the judge and may be asked to execute a figure of eight and/or perform other appropriate tests. Judged 75% on handling of reins and whip, control, posture and overall appearance of driver; 25% on the condition of harness and vehicle and neatness of attire.

Liberty

Classes are to be judged on creativity, originality, dramatic and or humorous value and manners. Excessive speed or unsafe conduct is to be severely penalized or disqualified.

Hunter

Over Fences (O/F): To be shown over a course of a minimum of six fences with eight jumping efforts of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement, and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Fence Height to be 18" for Low Hunter. Fence Height for the other hunter classes to be designated by rider starting at 18"

Hunter Hack

Horses will be judged 70% on the work over fences and 30% for flat work on the rail. If the horse is unable to complete the jumping section of the class he will be excused from the rail work and excused from the class. At the judge's discretion, a horse may be excused after three refusals.

Command Class

This is an elimination class. The judge will call a command and all riders must perform that command in a timely manner. Transitions should take no longer than three strides. The judge AND ring steward will record the back numbers as the riders are eliminated and called off the rail by "spotters". Once eliminated, riders will go to the center of the ring. The last rider that has performed all of the commands correctly will be the winner of the class.

Dressage Suitability Under Saddle

Judging will be based 90% on movement on Performance of the horse's gaits and transitions, with attention to impulsion and submission and using the objectives as a reference and 10% general impression. Includes harmony, athleticism, development related to age and condition, character, presence and temperament necessary for training.

Open Cross Rails W/T Equitation

Open to any age rider that is not showing in any walk/trot/canter or lope class at this show WITH THE EXCEPTION of Cross Rails Walk/Trot/Canter. Judged on rider's position & ability to use their riding aids. 4 Cross Rail Fences will be set no more than 18" tall and exhibitors will jump each fence once (1 time around). Flat class to be shown at the walk and trot both ways around the arena.

Open Cross Rails W/T/C Equitation

Open to any age rider that is in their first 12 months of showing over fences. Riders can cross enter into walk/trot classes, including walk/trot cross rails OR WPCSA Short Stirrup, but not both. Judged on rider's position & ability to use their riding aids. 4 Cross Rail Fences will be set no more than 18" tall and exhibitors will jump each fence twice(2 times around). Flat class to be shown at the walk, trot & canter both ways around the arena.

Walk/Trot Poles

Each entry will begin with a score of 70. The judge will assess penalty points for such things as ticks, hits, moving a pole, double striding, etc... and add or subtract maneuver points as warranted. Bonus points may be given for above average performance.

Leadline

The class will be judged and placed as an equitation class. The exhibitor will be judged on his or her basic position in the saddle.

Child's First Pony, over 12.2 hands

Section A, B, C, D and Half-Welsh/Part Breds, mare or gelding over 12.2 hands, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least eight, but no more that 14, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to enter the ring on the right rein (clockwise) and be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. Ponies to be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, manners, suitability and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class. There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.

Green Horse Western Pleasure, w/j

To show both ways of the ring and the walk and jog. Open to horse in their 1st year of showing under saddle. Year starts January 1st. May not enter in any other class at this show where the lope is required. Judged on manners, quality of gate and suitability as a pleasure horse.

Western Pleasure

Open to all riders, horses to be shown at a walk, jog and lope(walk/jog division not to lope) both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein, without undue restraint. To be judged 65% on performance with emphasis on manners; 25% on conformation and movement; 10% on appointments. No martingales, tiedowns or cavesons allowed. May use 2 hands with a snaffle or hackamore on any age horse. Any curb bit with a curb strap or curb chain must be ridden with one hand. Proper Western tack and attire required.

Western Horsemanship

Open to all rider to be judged on seat, hands, performance of animal, appointments of animal and rider and suitability of animal to rider. Tests or pattern may be required and will be posted 1 hour before class.

Ranch Riding

The purpose of the ranch riding class is to show a working horse's versatility, attitude and movement. The primary considerations are the horses' quality of movement and overall manners and responsiveness while performing the required maneuvers. The class should allow the horse to show its ability to work at a forward working speed while under the control of the rider. A horse being shown with light contact should be rewarded.

In-Hand Trail

Open to all horses and handlers, to be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot. To be judged 100% on performance.

Pet Pony Obstacle

Open to all horses and ponies for children age 11 and under. Age as of January 1st of this year. To be shown in-hand over and through obstacles at a walk and trot by handlers. To be judged 100% on performance and manners.

Trail

Open to all horses and riders, English or Western equipment. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, optional trot or jog and optional canter or lope. To be judged 100% on performance.

Walk Trot Trail

Open to all horses and riders, English or Western equipment. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, trot or jog. To be judged 100% on performance.
