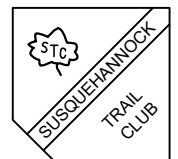

Lick Ridge, Railroad Grade and
Susquehannock Trails

In June of 2020 Susquehannock Trail Club (STC) member Jim Bowser set about to find and reopen the Lick Ridge Trail which had become overgrown and lost. With the assistance of DCNR/BOF personnel Jim relocated, cleared, blazed and made signs for this trail that dates from the CCC and lumbering days of Potter County.

Sadly, in October of 2021, our friend Jim passed away just as his project was nearing completion.

Other members of the STC joined together to complete the blazing and signage of this trail.

Loop Hike

A to B to C to D to E to F to B to A

The Lick Ridge Trail (LRT) provides the opportunity for a strenuous 11 mile loop day hike or a more leisurely 2 day loop hike with an overnight at the newest shelter on the Susquehannock Trail System (STS).

Point to Point Hike

E to D to G

Additionally a pleasant 3.3 mile point to point day hike can be enjoyed by spotting cars and hiking from the start of the LRT near the end of Boone Run Road (-E-) to the intersection of the STS and Short Run Road (-G-).

Loop Hike

- Start at the fire tower parking area (-A-) and proceed south (downhill) on the STS.
- Cross the Railroad Grade Trail (RGT) at (-B-).
- At (-C-) is the Bolich Run Shelter.
- At (-D-) cross the creek. There is a tiny island in the middle of the creek. The east channel can be crossed on the large stones. There are 2 iron I-beams crossing the west channel.
- Follow the LRT north along the creek till the trail turns uphill after 1/2 mile.
- At (-E-) the LRT ends. Turn right onto the Boone Trail.
- The Boone Trail is a roadway for 1/2 mile then is a footpath along the old roadbed.
- At (-F-) turn right onto the RGT.
- At (-B-) turn left onto the STS and proceed uphill to the fire tower.

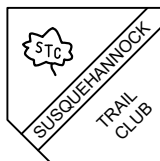
Point to Point Hike

- Start at (-E-). There is shoulder parking along Boone Trail. (Be careful not to block the trail)
- Hike southeast along the LRT to the creek crossing at (-D-). There is a tiny island in the middle of the creek. The east channel can be crossed on the large stones. There are 2 iron I-beams crossing the west channel.
- Turn right, south, and follow the STS to Short Run Road. (Plenty of parking at Short Run Road)
