Compare Mark Robertson and Dina Titus on **the issues**. Mark clearly represents the people of Nevada's First Congressional District better.

<b>Social Security</b> Social Security and Medicare are headed for bankruptcy in just a few years. Seniors could see a cut in their monthly income and a rise in their healthcare costs. Titus believes that bureaucrats in Washington should dictate education decisions for Nevada families. She puts the interests of lobbyists and political donors ahead of the welfare of our children. Her failures have contributed to Nevada's ranking 49 <sup>th</sup> in math, reading, and science.
<b>Loyalty</b> Nevadans want representatives who put people before party and principles before politics.	Mark will be loyal to the Constitution and to the people he represents, not to any party, person, lobbyist, or corporation.	Titus repeatedly votes against the will of the people she is supposed to represent. She votes with her extreme liberal friends and the Democrat party nearly 100% of the time.
