Club History



In the beginning...

It was a dark cold night in the Hawkesbury, early 2017, the wind could be heard whistling through the trees, the sound of willow and leather had come to an end. Tall white posts were soon to be seen on the horizon in local fields and it was only a matter of time before the beloved pig skin balls would make the return to the fields.....what no one could predict was the greatest club in junior league history was about to be unveiled.... For the founders of this venture had a dream, a place where all could come and play, a place where skills and natural talent was heavily outweighed by your commitment to team and family.

The native magpie would once again make a triumph return to the Hawkesbury and conquer the hearts of all that walked there.

This is their story...

The season was upon and disappointed with the current junior league environment a local Hawkesbury resident named Darrin Rawlings had approached rugby league friend and fellow Hawkesbury resident Anthony Magann with an idea to create a new club for the Hawkesbury.

After some reservations Anthony finally saw the light and together with Darrin, they began the early whispers, put pen to paper and brain-stormed possible ideas, locations and names. Not realising the future that was about to unfold.....

A few ideas had been shuffled about over a cold beverage or two at the local Bligh Park tavern circa 1990's. Some suggestions being the Kurrajong Cowboys, the Pitt Town Bulldogs, the McGraths Hill Maggots, eventually they settled on the Pitt Town Magpies. The Pies!

From here Rawlings researched on growth areas within the district and Junior League and found that the north west corridor would be a suitable location. Further cementing the Pitt Town Magpies concept. Early unofficial meetings held with the junior league board sought approval for affiliation. Negotiation were held as to if the northwest corridor would fall under the Penrith Junior league or Parramatta junior league. It was found the area would fall under the Penrith zone so planning continued....

From the midpoint of 2017, Rawlings and Magann gathered support from close friends, the Cooper and Nash families to form the initial executive committee. This committee comprised of Darrin Rawlings, Anthony Magann, Melinda Cooper, Angela Jones and Ben Nash. Rawlings and Magann knew that they needed a partnership with a local family that is well respected within the community. Private talks between Rawlings, Magann and local long-standing community member Ben Fowler began. All three had previously worked together in junior league and this seemed to be the perfect fit.

It was at this point the support had started to come, the expansion of the executive grew to a general committee and the Gibson family and Tanti families were great additions to help the club.

Rawlings continued to work on the documentation needed to ensure the club could become official meanwhile Magann gathered local support of his peers from previous years gone by. The Committee planned and executed Come Try Rugby days, BBQ fundraisers and most importantly our first ever leaflet drop.

During meetings with the junior league the concept of a broader name was floated to not only include Pitt Town but also the entire NORTH WEST corridor covering from Windsor to Rouse Hill. Not wanting to lose our identity so soon but realising the potential for future growth it was decided to drop the "Pitt Town" section of the name and rebrand as THE NORTH WEST MAGPIES.

The club motto of "Developing Players" was raised by Rawlings some months earlier after hearing a junior league representative speech discussing development of players. This seemed the perfect fit and soon become a vital part of the magpies. Magann worked on a club logo incorporating the club's latest motto "Developing Players" This logo and credo still stands today.

Meanwhile the Cooper, Nash, Gibson and Tanti families kept working promoting the new venture. More clinics in the local area and schools took place.

The word spread quick through the local community and enquiries for registration were not too far away. Meanwhile official affiliation was still not secured, and the committee knew that all their hard work could be for nothing however this did not stop them.

After meeting with the Pitt Town Sports Club, it was decided that this would be the official home, a place to hang their hat. The magpies also needed more local support and a partnership was formed with the Sheridan family.

It was the belief of both and support of the Sheridan and Fowler families that ensured the Magpies would be a success. The initial approval was granted by the junior league in August of 2017 however an official acceptance into the league could not happen until December 2017 at the Leagues AGM.

In December 2017 the notification was received. The North West Magpies were officially accepted into the Penrith Junior Rugby League.

From this point on the greatest club in junior league history had begun to spread its wings....

Season 2018 kicked off the maiden year with many a victory and smile both on and off the field. Some 66 local juniors took the leap of faith and carved out a new way to enjoy rugby league where player development stood tall above all.

By 2019 numbers had near tripled, the growth both Rawlings and Magann had predicted had come to fruition. The North West Magpies had proved they were not just a one trick wonder.

Word soon begun to spread that the only place to play in the Hawkesbury was at the Magpies.

Season 2020 saw a pandemic that we have never endured before. Junior Rugby League had hit rock bottom. Local clubs across Australia would fold closing doors on the history pages that adorn the rugby league libraries. Despite all the challenges the Magpies continued to grow. Player numbers would now sit a quadruple the foundation season.

The pandemic may have caused a delay to the season but it most certainly could not hold down the power of the Magpie. 2020 finished in style with multiple grand final teams numerous Penrith Panther Representative honours, but for these humble magpies most importantly, players finished their year smiling and enjoying the great game of rugby league.

2021 saw Sunday Senior Footy start with our U16s & new U18s team, shorter season, we played 9 games from 15 this season due to Covid.

By the commencement of season 2021 the pandemic was somewhat forgotten, and the season would start strong. With little under 300 players and dozens and dozens of staff members the Magpies would start the year for the first time ever in Sunday senior football. Fielding their first ever division 1 team, this team would further display the developing players creed.

With age groups in the 16's and 18's Sunday competition the Magpies continued to leave their mark on the junior league. The dream of Rawlings, Magann, Cooper and Nash families had finally reached the top of the mountain. Fielding teams in all ages from under 5's thru 18's, the hard work and dedication had finally shown its reward.

A moment to truly be proud of.

Capping of what can only be described as a remarkable first 4 years the North West Magpies were crowned 2021 Panthers Juniors 'Club of the Year', this award is a testament to the work put in by all members of the magpies community....

For the Magpies the horizon is huge, the windscreen is full of great moments ahead and the rear view mirror whilst small holds an amazing amount of memories... This is not the end..... just a new pathway.

The nest is not completed... their new home awaits ...

The greatest club in junior league history have spread their wings....leaving a mark in history that cannot be denied....

May they continue to soar.....

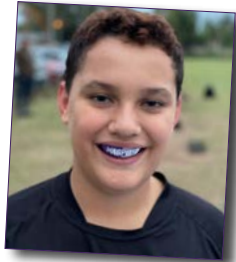
