

Free Trial Service Terms & Conditions

“Free-Trial Order” means an order for Free-Trial Services pursuant to this Agreement completed and submitted by Customer online at the next vision website and accepted by next vision ltd, including any Customer registration for Free-Trial Services, or executed by next vision ltd and Customer.

“Free-Trial Services” means any Services made available by next vision to Customer free of charge under a Free-Trial Order and

Free trial period : The free trial period will be for a) 30 days starting from the service activation date. b) without any setup or subscription charges.

“Free-Trial Term” means, with respect to each Free-Trial Order, the period from the effective date of the Free-Trial Order through termination pursuant to Section

“Paid Services” means the Services to which Customer subscribes through, or otherwise uses following, a Paid Order.

“Party” means each of next vision and Customer.

“Services” means the broadband services that are made available by next vision ltd to the customer.

1. Free-Trial Orders.

This Agreement sets forth the terms pursuant to which Customer may access and use the Free-Trial Services in connection with one or more Free-Trial Orders Subject to the terms of a Free-Trial Order

3. Free trial period

The free trial period will be for a) 30 days starting from the service activation date. b) without any setup or subscription charges.

4. Access and Use.

Subject to the applicable Free-Trial Order and this Agreement, next vision ltd hereby grants to Customer the right to access and use the Free-Trial broadband Services in accordance with the Documentation during the Free-Trial Term for Customer’s Environment.

5. Duration and cancellation.

- 5.1 After the Free Trial Period, If the customer would like to subscribe to next vision broadband paid services, then the customer has the option to choose the service plan that suites his needs and

sign a typical 12-month contract along with the package of his/her choice.

- 5.2 If the customer is no longer interested in our service, simply pack away the equipment (in a good and original condition) and we will collect it from you at the nearest convenient time suited the customer. We will then arrange for the service to be cancelled.

6. Free-Trial Subscription.

Next vision will make the Free-Trial Services available to Customer until the earliest of: (a) the end of the period specified in the applicable Free-Trial Order; (b) the start date of any Paid Order for the applicable Services; (c) termination by next vision ltd, at any time, in its sole discretion; or (d) termination by Customer pursuant to Section 5. Additional terms and conditions, including Supplemental Terms, may apply to Free-Trial Services and Customer agrees any such additional terms and conditions are incorporated into this Agreement by reference and are legally binding.

7. Term and Termination.

- 7.1 The term of this Agreement will continue through the last Free-Trial Term to be in effect.
- 7.2 Upon expiration or earlier termination of a Free-Trial Order: (a) All rights granted to Customer with respect to Free-Trial Services under such Free-Trial Order will terminate effective as of the effective date of termination and (b) next vision ltd will have no obligation to provide Free-Trial Services to Customer after the effective date of the termination.

8. Equipment's :

- 8.1 1 In order to provide the Customer with the broadband Services, the company will provide the Customer with the necessary Openreach approved modem/router and any Equipment provided by the company will be remain the property of the company for the duration of this contract.
- 8.2 The Customer shall keep the Equipment and the original packaging in a good condition shall not tamper with such packaging. If the Equipment is damaged or the original packing is lost then the Customer is liable to pay the total cost of the Equipment that they have received.

9. Changes to this Agreement.

Next vision ltd may modify this Agreement at any time by posting a revised version <https://next-vision.co.uk/legal-%26-policies> which modifications will become effective as of the first day of the calendar month following the month in which they were first posted. If Customer objects to the updated Agreement, as its sole and exclusive remedy, Customer may choose to stop using the Free-Trial Services and terminate all Free-Trial Orders and this Agreement upon written notice to next vision. For the avoidance of doubt, any Free-Trial Order is subject to the version of the Agreement in effect at the time of the Free-Trial Order.
