Dear Lot Owners and Association Members:

With appreciation for the progress you continue to make in caring for your lakes, I am writing to provide you with an update on the land owned by the Amanda Haralson Stover Trust which surrounds both lakes and which is managed as timber land and wildlife habitat.

I have placed most of the surrounding land in a Conservation Trust to protect it in perpetuity from development. My son, Seth Haralson Stover, is working with me and we are developing a wildlife management plan to help offset the growing human population density of the area.

Concurrent with these moves, we have reached the sad realization that we are left with no choice but to "post" the land surrounding the lakes as allowed by Texas Law. This means that, effective immediately, lot owners and their guests no longer have access to the posted lands. This action is necessitated due to the abuse over the decades by a few lot owners and occasional outside trespassers by hunting on the land; riding all terrain vehicles, dirt bikes and four-wheelers on the timberland and bottom lands; and persistently dumping household goods on the timberland creating an eyesore and, in some instances, creating a health risk. In addition to the erosion caused by the riding of the forbidden all terrain vehicles, thousands of dollars of young pine trees have been destroyed.

Please know that I wish you the very best and look forward to years of continued joint enjoyment of the lakes my parents built.
