While most visitors are respectful, some have caused disturbances or been found wandering unattended in the neighborhood or in the clubhouse area.

We're proud of how responsive and proactive our neighborhood watch has been. Thanks to your vigilance, quick communication and willingness to look out for one another, we've been able to address incidents as they arise and help maintain the safety and integrity of our park.

We can all make our community a safer place by reporting suspicious activity to the police and to park management. Suspicious activity can refer to any incident, event, individual or activity that seems unusual or out of place. If you see something, say something. Don't assume that someone else has reported an issue. Police and park management won't know there's a problem unless they are informed.
