Looking Into The International Crisis Caused by the Bosnian Genocide

Background

After the dissolution of Yugoslavia, there was a lot of leftover tension between the remaining and newly independent states. The most prominent attention was located between the states of Serbia and Bosnia where a Racial divide would eventually boil over into an international crisis and eventual genocide of the Bosnian people. This conflict stems from multiple border disputes in the Balkan region, as the nations of Croatia, Bosnia, and Serbia dispute over the fine line between sovereign borders, ancestral calming, and the locations of certain racial populations that do not align with the current borders. And without a unifying leader to ease racial tensions, certain Serbian back groups decided to take to violence.

1992 marked the true beginning of what would be known as the Bosnian genocide. With what is to be assumed to be the Serbian military (although was heavily denied at the time even with the presence of overwhelming contradictory evidence. Serbia was directly involved), began a heavy push into Bosnia with the goal of the ethnic cleansing and eventual mass genocide of the Bosnian people in the region. Killing almost 100,000 innocents and displacing countless others. As this tragedy swept the region the economic and political damage was felt all over the globe making this situation global in every sense of the word.

Interviews

With insight from various interviews with notable delegates such as representatives from Montenegro and Russia, we have gained a considerable intuitional understanding of their stance. It is undeniable that the genocide in Bosnia is a deeply complex abuse of circumstance used to prey on helpless civilians to fuel racial tensions. Therefore, we believe that delegates' insight is essential to understand the issue at hand properly. For instance, in the interview with the delegate from Montenegro, an interesting point of view was stated: "I believe that the West intervening will increase casualties to immense extents, and this is not justified. I think the answer comes in Balkin nations coming together and promoting integration to the point of the diffusion of racial tensions and rebuilding nations' relations."

The Bosnian genocide has taken a massive toll on everyone involved. With murder, rape, and a number of other war crimes ever present this is truly a defining tragedy in global history.
