INFORMATION SHEET FOR SPONSORS

Requirements and Guidelines for Potential Candidates

1. The candidate has the potential to be a leader and is capable of acting as an evangelical leaven in his/her environments.
2. The candidate must be 21 years of age or older and mature enough to understand the evangelical message and commit to it.
3. It is recommended that the husband, as the spiritual head of the family attend a Cursillo weekend before his wife. The Cursillo Movement holds in highest regard the Sacrament of Marriage. If only one spouse is to live the Weekend, the sponsors responsibility is to inform the couple of:
 - A full explanation of the purpose and method of the Cursillo Movement.
 - A complete explanation of what is expected of those who attend the 3-day weekend.
 - Most importantly is the explanation of what is expected during the 4th day (Group Reunion and Ultreya)
 - Make Sure that both agree that one spouse attending the weekend while the other spouse does not, will not have an adverse effect on their Sacrament of Marriage.
4. The candidate must be Catholic who is in a position, or can be in a position to receive the Sacraments of the Catholic Church.
5. There must exist the opportunity for follow-up and support of the Cursillista by the Cursillo community through Group Reunion and Ultreya. **(Remember: The main job of the sponsor begins after the candidate has attended the Cursillo weekend.)**
6. The Candidate should not be under any unusual stress. (Out of respect for the candidate and in courtesy to other attendees as well, the Cursillo weekend is not to be used as a “cure” for marital or emotional problems, substance abuse, etc. Doing so incurs the risk of causing more harm than good)
7. Consult your potential candidate’s pastor if you have any major questions, concerns, or doubts regarding his/her eligibility to live a Cursillo weekend.

Sponsor’s Responsibilities to the Candidate

As a sponsor you have the responsibility to:

- Pray before contacting a potential applicant.
- Explain the purpose and method of the movement.
- Explain the importance of 4th day. (Group Reunion and Ultreya)
- If possible, explain Cursillo to both husband and wife.
- Personally bring your candidate to the Cursillo weekend, or arrange transportation. Candidates should not drive themselves to the Cursillo.
- Do Palanca for your candidate and write a general and personal Palanca note.
- Provide assistance to your candidate’s family as needed during the 3-day weekend.
- Attend Clausura and take your candidate home or make arrangements to get him/her home. Also notify the candidate and spouse of the approximate time of return on Sunday evening.
- After the weekend; Help your candidate to find a permanent Group Reunion. Invite and take your Candidate to the Ultreya held for new Cursillistas. Tell your candidate about coming back to work on weekends.
- Inform the candidate that they will be asked to turn off their cell phones for the weekend, also inform the candidate and spouse of the weekend emergency phone number at St. Mary’s in Oregon **(815)200-9733**
