Leader: Opening Prayer:

God of power and mercy, in love you sent your Son that we might be cleansed of sin and live with you forever. Bless us as we gather to reflect on his suffering and death that we may learn from his example the way we should go. We ask this through that same Christ, our Lord.

All: Amen.

Leader: First Station: Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." He took along Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to feel sorrow and distress. Then he said to them, "My soul is sorrowful even to death. Remain here and keep watch with me." He advanced a little and fell prostrate in prayer, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet, not as I will, but as you will." When he returned to his disciples he found them asleep. He said to Peter, "So you could not keep watch with me for one hour? Watch and pray that you may not undergo the test. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." (Matthew 26:36-41)

Leader: Lord, grant us your strength and wisdom, that we may seek to follow your will in all things

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps.

Leader: Second Station: Jesus, Betrayed by Judas, is Arrested - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: Then, while [Jesus] was still speaking, Judas, one of the Twelve, arrived, accompanied by a crowd with swords and clubs, who had come from the chief priests, the scribes, and the elders. His betrayer had arranged a signal with them, saying, "the man I shall kiss is the one; arrest him and lead him away securely." He came and immediately went over to him and said, "Rabbi." And he kissed him. At this they laid hands on him and arrested him. (Mark 14: 43-46)

Leader: Lord, grant us the courage of our convictions that our lives may faithfully reflect the good news you bring.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps.

Leader: Third Station: Jesus is Condemned by the Sanhedrin - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: When day came the council of elders of the people met, both chief priests and scribes, and they brought him before their Sanhedrin. They said, "If you are the Messiah, tell us," but he replied to them, "If I tell you, you will not believe, and if I question, you will not respond. But from this time on the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the power of God." They all asked, "Are you then the Son of God?" He replied to them, "You say that I am." Then they said, "What further need have we for testimony? We have heard it from his own mouth." (Luke 22: 66-71)

Leader: Lord, grant us your sense of righteousness that we may never cease to work to bring about the justice of the kingdom that you promised.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps.

Leader: Fourth Station: Jesus is Denied by Peter - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard. One of the maids came over to him and said, "You too were with Jesus the Galilean." But he denied it in front of everyone, saying, "I do not know what you are talking about!" As he went out to the gate, another girl saw him and said to those who were there, "This man was with Jesus the Nazorean." Again he denied it with an oath, "I do not know the man!" A little later the bystanders came over and said to Peter, "Surely you too are one of them; even your speech gives you away." At that he began to curse and to swear, "I do not know the man." And immediately a cock crowed. Then Peter remembered the word that Jesus had spoken: "Before the cock crows you will deny me three times." He went out and began to weep bitterly. (Matthew 26: 69-75)

Leader: Lord, grant us the gift of honesty that we may not fear to speak the truth even when difficult.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps.

Leader: Fifth Station: Jesus is Judged by Pilate - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: The chief priests with the elders and the scribes, that is, the whole Sanhedrin, held a council. They bound Jesus, led him away, and handed him over to Pilate. Pilate questioned him, "Are you the king of the Jews?" He said to him in reply, "You say so." The chief priests accused him of many things. Again Pilate questioned him, "Have you no answer? See how many things they accuse you of." Jesus gave him no further answer, so that Pilate was amazed.... Pilate, wishing to satisfy the crowd, released Barrabas... [and] handed [Jesus] over to be crucified. (Mark 15: 1-5, 15)

Leader: Lord, grant us discernment that we may see as you see, not as the world sees.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps.

Leader: Sixth Station: Jesus is Scourged and Crowned with Thorns - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: Then Pilate took Jesus and had him scourged. And the soldiers wove a crown out of thorns and placed it on his head, and clothed him in a purple cloak, and they came to him and said, "Hail, King of the Jews!" And they struck him repeatedly. (John 19: 1-3)

Leader: Lord, grant us patience in times of suffering that we may offer our lives as a sacrifice of praise.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Seventh Station: Jesus Bears the Cross - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: When the chief priests and the guards saw [Jesus] they cried out, "Crucify him, crucify him!" Pilate said to them, "Take him yourselves and crucify him. I find no guilt in him." ... They cried out, "Take him away, take him away! Crucify him!" Pilate said to them, "Shall I crucify your king?" The chief priests answered, "We have no king but Caesar." Then he handed him over to them to be crucified. So they took Jesus, and carrying the cross himself he went out to what is called the Place of the Skull, in Hebrew, Golgotha. (John 19: 6, 15-17)

Leader: Lord, grant us strength of purpose that we may faithfully bear our crosses each day.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Eighth Station: Jesus is Helped by Simon the Cyrenian to Carry the Cross - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: They pressed into service a passer-by, Simon, a Cyrenian, who was coming in from the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to carry his cross. (Mark 15: 21)

Leader: Lord, grant us willing spirits that we may be your instruments on earth.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Ninth Station: Jesus Meets the Women of Jerusalem - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: A large crowd of people followed Jesus, including many women who mourned and lamented him. Jesus turned to them and said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me; weep instead for yourselves and for your children, for indeed, the days are coming when people will say, 'Blessed are the barren, the wombs that never bore and the breasts that never nursed.' At that time, people will say to the mountains, 'Fall upon us!' and to the hills, 'Cover us!' for if these things are done when the wood is green what will happen when it is dry?" (Luke 23: 27-31)

Leader: Lord, grant us gentle spirits that we may comfort those who mourn.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Tenth Station: Jesus is Crucified -We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

Reader: When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified him and the criminals there, one on his right, the other on his left. [Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do."]. (Luke 23: 33-34)

Leader: Lord, grant us merciful hearts that we may bring your reconciliation and forgiveness to all.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Eleventh Station: Jesus Promises His Kingdom to the Good Thief -We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

Reader: Now one of the criminals hanging there reviled Jesus, saying, "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us." When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple there whom he loved, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son." Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother." And from that hour the disciple took her into his home. (John 19: 25-27)

Leader: Lord, grant us constancy. that we may be willing to stand by those in need.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Thirteenth Station: Jesus Dies on the Cross - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: It was now about noon and darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon because of an eclipse of the sun. Then the veil of the temple was torn down the middle. Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit"; and when he had said this he breathed his last. (Luke 23: 44-46)

Leader: Lord, grant us trust in you that when our time on earth ended our spirits may come to you without delay.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader: Fourteenth Station: Jesus is Placed in the Tomb - We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you.

All: Because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.

Reader: When it was evening, there came a rich man from Arimathea named Joseph, who was himself a disciple of Jesus. He went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus; then Pilate ordered it to be handed over. Taking the body, Joseph wrapped it [in] clean linen and laid it in his new tomb that he had hewn in the rock. Then he rolled a huge stone across the entrance to the tomb and departed. (Matthew 27: 57-60)

Leader: Lord, grant us your compassion that we may always provide for those in need.

All: Lord Jesus, help us walk in your steps

Leader Closing Prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ, your passion and death is the sacrifice that unites earth and heaven and reconciles all people to you. May we who have faithfully reflected on these mysteries follow in your steps and so come to share your glory in heaven where you live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit one God, for ever and ever.

All: Amen.

Way of the Cross Preparatory Prayer *

All: O Jesus, my adorable Savior, I seek Your forgiveness and mercy for myself and for my loved ones, for those hardened by sin, and all the faithful departed. Wash away my sins and those of the whole world through the infinite merits of Your Passion. Give me the grace to enter more deeply into the mystery of Your Cross, so that sharing in Your suffering and death, I may experience a deep sorrow for my sins and be ready to embrace willingly, even with joy, all the sufferings and humiliations of this life and pilgrimage.

The First Station: Jesus Is Condemned to Death

Meditation: Recall how Jesus was scourged and crowned with thorns, and how He was then unjustly condemned by Pilate to die on the Cross. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: Adorable Jesus, it was not Pilate; it was my own sins that condemned You to death. I pray You, by the merits of Your sorrowful Journey to Calvary, to assist my soul on its journey to eternity.

The Second Station: Jesus Accepts His Cross

Meditation: Recall how the heavy Cross was laid upon Jesus' bused shoulders. He accepts it meekly and courageously, because by that Cross He wills to redeem the world. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: O Jesus, by the merit of Your Cross, grant me the grace to accept meekly and cheerfully the difficulties in my life, that, by so doing, I may always be ready to take up my cross and follow You.

The Third Station: Jesus Falls For The First Time

Meditation: Laboring under the weight of the Cross, Jesus slowly sets forth on the way to Calvary. His agony in the garden has exhausted His Body; He is sore with blows and wounds; His strength fails Him; He falls to the ground under the Cross. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: It was for my sins, my Jesus, that You bore the heavy burden of Your Cross and fell under its weight. Let my remembrance of these sufferings make me careful, lest I fall into mortal sin.

The Fourth Station: Jesus Meets His Afflicted Mother

Meditation: Recall the meeting between Son and Mother on the way to Calvary. How oppressive that experience must have been for both of them! What a sword of anguish must have pierced Mary's maternal heart. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: My Jesus, by the compassion which You felt for Your Mother, have compassion on me, and permit me to share in her intercession with You. O Mary, afflicted Mother, intercede for me with your Son, that by His sufferings I may be saved from the wrath which is to come.

The Fifth Station: Simon of Cyrene Helps Jesus Carry the Cross

Meditation: Recall how, as Jesus' strength continued to fail, He became unable to go on; and how the soldiers then seized Simon of Cyrene and forced him to help Jesus carry His Cross. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: O Lord Jesus, let me also bear Your Cross; let me glory in nothing else. Let the temptations of this world be crucified to me, and I to them. Let me not shrink from suffering; let me rather rejoice to be counted worthy of suffering for Your Name's sake.

The Sixth Station: Veronica Offers Her Veil to Jesus

Meditation: Recall how Veronica, seeing Jesus so afflicted, His face soiled with sweat and blood, offered Him her veil. Jesus took the veil, wiped His face, and left imprinted on the cloth the image of His Divine Countenance. (short pause). **Let us pray:**

Prayer: O Jesus, may the remembrance of Your suffering move me to hatred for my sins; may it stir up in me a more fervent love for You. Let the image of Your Countenance be impressed upon my mind until I am made over in Your likeness.

The Seventh Station: Jesus Falls for the Second Time

Meditation: Recall how Jesus' struggle to go on increased His pain and cost Him a constantly greater loss of blood, until His strength failed a second time, and He fell upon the ground again. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: O Jesus, lying prostrate again under the burden of my sins, how often have I offended You in the past? Let me for the future rather die than ever offend You again.

The Eighth Station: Jesus Speaks to the Women of Jerusalem

Meditation: Recall how some holy women of Jerusalem, upon seeing Jesus stumbling along and bathed in His own blood, wept with compassion. To them Jesus said: "Do not weep for Me; weep instead for yourselves and for your children." (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: O Lord Jesus, I grieve for Your sufferings, too, and for my sins which caused You to suffer. Let me mourn that I may be comforted. Let me escape the awful judgment that awaits those who reject and neglect You in this earthly life.

The Ninth Station: Jesus Falls for the Third Time

Meditation: Jesus, arriving exhausted at the foot of Calvary, falls for the third time. His weakness was extreme and the cruelty of His executioners was excessive; they tried to hasten His steps when He hardly had the strength to move. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: O Lord Jesus, I pray You, by the merits of this third painful fall, to forgive my frequent falls into sin and my slowness to rise and return to You. Let the remembrance of Your sufferings make me hate my sins more and more.

The Tenth Station: Jesus is Stripped of His Garments

Meditation: Recall now how Jesus arrived at the place of His Crucifixion. The soldiers tore His clothes from His bleeding Body, leaving Him exposed to the cold, rude stare of the scoffing crowd. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: Innocent Jesus, by Your torment in being stripped of your clothing, help me to put off every inordinate attachment to the things of earth, so that I may give all my love to You, who are all worthy of my love.

The Eleventh Station: Jesus is Nailed to the Cross

Meditation: Recall how Jesus lies down upon His Cross, and how He extends His arms to offer up the sacrifice of His Life for our salvation. The soldiers nail Him, hands and feet, to His gibbet. And then they raise it, leaving Him to die upon it in terrible anguish. (short pause) **Let us pray:**

Prayer: My crucified Jesus, bind my heart to Your Cross, and let it remain there always never again to forsake You.

The Twelfth Station: Jesus Dies on the Cross

Meditation: *Recall how Jesus agonized for three hours, dying upon the Cross. Then overcome at last, His Body sagged limply; His head fell forward upon His chest; and he handed over His Spirit. (short pause) Let us pray:*

Prayer: O Jesus, I devoutly honor that Holy Cross upon which You loved me even unto death. In You death is all my hope. From this time forward, let me live only for You; when I come to die, let me die loving You alone.

The Thirteenth Station: Jesus is Taken Down From the Cross

Meditation: *Recall how two of His disciples, Joseph and Nicodemus, took Jesus' body down from His Cross, and how they laid Him in the arms of His stricken Mother. She received Him with tenderness passing Him close to her afflicted heart. (short pause) Let us pray:*

Prayer: Mother of Sorrows, for the love of Your Son, take me for your servant and pray to Him on my behalf. And You, dear Jesus, who died for me, let me love You; let me desire You and You alone.

The Fourteenth Station: Jesus is Laid in the Sepulcher

Meditation: *The Body of her dearly beloved Sone is taken from His Mother and laid in the tomb. The is closed and the lifeless Body remains until the hour of it glorious Resurrection. (short pause) Let us pray:*

Prayer: O Jesus, lying buried in the tomb, I reverently kiss the stone that encloses You. But on the third day, You rose in glory. By the resurrection, call me too to rise in glory on the last day, to be forever united with You.

(A) Fill them with Your Spirit which will make them preachers of Your Word, ministers of Your Sacrifice, servants of Your Bride, friends of the poor, and the voice of the forgotten.

(B) Transform them through your Holy Spirit so that they may transform the world into Your Kingdom of justice and faith.

(All) Amen.

A Prayer For Priests - by: Cardinal O'Connor *

(A) Jesus, we your people pray to You for our priests. You have given them to us for OUR needs. We pray for them in their needs.

(B) We know that You have made them priests in the likeness of your own priesthood. You have consecrated them, set them aside, anointed them, filled them with the Holy Spirit, appointed them to teach, to preach, to minister, to console, to forgive, and to feed us with Your Body and Blood.

(A) Yet we know, too, that they are one with us and share our human weaknesses. We know too that they are tempted to sin and discouragement as are we, needing to be ministered to, as do we, to be consoled and forgiven, as do we. Indeed, we thank You for choosing them from among us, so that they understand us as we understand them, suffer with us and rejoice with us, worry with us and trust with us, share our beings, our lives, our faith.

(B) We ask that You give them this day the gift You gave Your chosen ones on the way to Emmaus: Your presence in their hearts, Your holiness in their souls, Your joy in their spirits. And let them see You face to face in the breaking of the Eucharistic bread.

(All) We pray to You, O Lord, through Mary the mother of all priests, for Your priests and for ours. Amen

(A) Make me pure, my Jesus. Make me long for union with You in prayer more than anything else in this world. Make me spiritually beautiful so that all the people whose lives I touch will want what You give and will crave holiness. I want to carry You to Your people.

(B) Remind me of the value of my little aches and pains so that I remember to offer them back to You for the salvation of souls. Make me ever grateful for every present You send me.

Leader: Body of Christ, Save Me.

(A) Dear Jesus, Your body was killed, brutally murdered, all for Your love. I keep trying to understand more fully how Your death was necessary for our salvation. It seems so senseless when thinking about it in human terms.

(B) Nonetheless, I trust that I will find the salvation for which you gave Your life if I keep my sights on You. I can now receive You into my own body through the Blessed Sacrament. Please, dear Lord, lift the veil once in a while. Let me catch even just an occasional fleeting glimpse of awareness of what Your presence in the Eucharist is.

(A) When I plead with You to forget my sins, remember how hard I tried to comprehend Your presence to me in the Eucharist. Remember how much I longed for the healing of Your Sacramental presence. Remember how I tried to love You, even though I fell hopelessly short.

Leader: Blood of Christ, Inebriate Me.

(B) My sweet Jesus, Your precious Blood no longer flows onto the hard, dry earth, but I know Your wounds always bleed for love of us, for love of me. Thank You for suffering for me.

(A) It is finished now. You won! You died for us and You won! Now I don't need to fear my sinfulness anymore. I can despise it and try to eradicate it, but fear is no longer the issue. Your mercy saves me. All I need to do is the best that I can, profess my sorrow at my failings, and You will wash me clean in Your Blood.

(B) It is exciting, my Lord! You did all the dirty work, and I can reap the rewards. It isn't fair at all. How can I ever be grateful enough? How can I fail to love You and to trust You?

Leader: Water From the Side of Christ, Wash Me.

(A) My very humanness, dear Jesus, makes me sinful. Although I know that You washed me clean of original sin in Baptism, I still have to take responsibility for my response to my own sinful nature. I am sorry for all my sins, dear Lord, and I beg You to continually wash away the guilt I carry.

(B) Thank You, Jesus, for the wonderful Sacrament of Reconciliation. In it I can experience the actual washing clean of my soul which You accomplished for me on Calvary. The water flowing from Your side to cleanse me of my guilt is a shower of mercy I need all the time.

Leader: Passion of Christ, Strengthen Me.

(A) Dear Jesus, You suffered so much to save me from the clutches of evil, and You are all powerful, By virtue of Your Passion, I beg You to be my force against evil.

(B) I am weak, Lord, but I thank You for my weakness. If I had been mighty, I might not be as quick to realize how much I need Your strength. I want to depend on You. My little crosses are so much easier to bear when I have Your help to carry them. And Your help is what gives my crosses meaning and value; if You didn't help me carry them, they would be useless because they wouldn't be united with Your Passion.

Leader: O Good Jesus, Hear Me.

(A) You never turn Your back on me, dear Lord. I have called, and You have answered. At the same time as I thank You for the mercy You've shown me, again, I beg You to hear the petitions I bring to You.

(B) I ask for so much from You, sweet Jesus, but You are the only One who can give me what I seek. I trust in Your mercy and love, and my repetition of my requests isn't because I don't trust You, but rather because I don't trust myself to have always asked in the right way. I just did it again. I didn't trust that You would read my heart and know my needs. Dear Lord, more than anything, I need the presence of Your Spirit in my soul to increase my trust in You.

(A) Will You accept the burden of my petitions, Lord? Will You watch over them while I burrow deeper and deeper into Your Sacred Heart? Please help me. Please read my heart and know what troubles me. Please grant me the peace of Your care.

Leader: Within Thy Wounds, Hide Me.

(B) Sweet, precious Lord, the troubles of life in the world constantly keep my heart from being able to concentrate on You. Don't let me become

so involved in earthly matters that I lose track of You.

(A) I trust in the power of Your love, ever present in the wounds which always bleed for me. Shelter me from anything which keeps my heart from actively seeking You, My God.

Leader: Suffer Me Not to be Separated From Thee

(B) Jesus, when I forget your will and follow my evil inclinations, please don't leave me floundering. Remember, I try to love You, even when I fail so miserably. You know my heart longs for You, even when I get distracted from You. I have to trust You to remember and not abandon me.

(A) Wake me up to Your presence in my life when I lose sight of You and Your way. I couldn't go on living if I thought there was a chance You would let me go.

Leader: From the Malignant Enemy, Defend Me.

Meeting Mary in Prayer

Perhaps Mary has walked down the streets of your neighborhood. Have you seen her? She wasn't wearing a blue and white robe and a long veil, but clothes much like those you and I might wear.

We can learn so much about Mary from all the "Marys" who live around us - all the women and girls we know who share so many of Mary's qualities: smart, kind, patient, honest, God-loving, hardworking, generous, modest, fun to be with - loving wives, mothers, sisters, and friends. They give us some idea of what a wonderful person Mary was.

Begin your prayer by greeting Mary as you would a dear friend. Think of how you say "hello" to your best friend, how you feel when you see her. Now greet Mary: **Hail Mary!** and as you go on with the words of your prayer, reflect on the following ideas:

full of grace - Think of some woman you know who makes you feel that she is all beautiful inside, full of all that is good, bursting with God's life. Mary was as full of God's grace as anyone could possibly be. She carried God's Son in her body for nine months and forever in her heart. (Pause)

the Lord is with you - Who are some women who have made you feel closer to God throughout the years of your life because they were so close to Him? Surely it can be said that the Lord was with them. Undoubtedly Mary played an important part in bringing them close to her Son. Let her do the same for you. Make Mary an important part of your prayer life not only in May but throughout the year. And the Lord will always be with you as well. (Pause)

Blessed are you among women - Who are the women you admire most, who make you feel your own goodness? Mary is blessed even more than these blessed women. Thank God for all blessed women and especially for Mary whom He gave us on the cross to be our Mother. (Pause)

Blessed is the Fruit of your womb, Jesus - Think of the new life a much loved baby in your own family or the baby of a friend has brought to the people in his or her little world. Then consider the tremendous new life that came into the world when Mary said yes to God. Jesus is a constant source of new life for us. In Him we can be born again and again. Praise Mary for the gift of her womb. (Pause)

Holy Mary, Mother of God - Think back to when you were small and how your mother cared for you. Let God's mother be your mother too. Tell her what you need each day so that she may bring your needs to her Son. (Pause)

Pray for us sinners - Did you ever talk over your weaknesses and problems with your mother or some other mother figure in your life? And did she help you to change and grow? Confess to Mary your failings, talk over with her the things about yourself that you would like to change. Ask Mary to comfort you and help you grow in your love of the Lord. (Pause)

Now, and at the hour of death. Amen - Think of beloved women in you family or friends or teachers who have died. Did they have happy deaths? And if so why? Share your feelings about death with Mary. Ask her to be with you when the hour of your death comes. (Pause)

Pray a Hail Mary

(After praying the Hail Mary),

Thank your heavenly mother in your own words for the help she has given you through all your life, and spend a few quiet moments just being together with her and her Son. (Pause)

**Way of the Cross,
Way of Reconciliation**
*A Penance Service Through
The Stations of the Cross*

Presider: Let us pray. Lord Jesus, you gave your life to show us how completely, how absolutely we are loved. It was not a swift, easy death, but involved prolonged suffering. We recall that death today not only to remind ourselves of your love, but to call to mind the sins for which you died. As we follow the way of your suffering and death, we ask you to open our hearts and help us see where we have failed, where we have caused suffering for you, for those around us and even for ourselves. We seek reconciliation with you and with one another, and so we prayerfully join you on your final Journey.

All: Amen

THE WAY OF THE CROSS

First Station: Jesus Is Condemned To Death

Reader I: Pilate had the authority to execute Jesus or set him free. Unable to find evidence against Jesus, he sentenced him to death and then publicly washed his hands of the whole business.

Reader II: Have I condemned others to suffering, alienation and even death by my indifference or anger? Even though I believe people to be innocent, do I join the crowd to condemn them?

All: Do I try to “wash my hands” of the consequences of my decisions, making excuses and pretending that it isn’t really my fault? Do I try to absolve myself and explain away my guilt instead of throwing myself on God’s mercy? For the times I have failed, Lord Have Mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Second Station: Jesus Takes Up His Cross

I: Knowing what was in store for him, Jesus had to carry the instrument of his own suffering and death. Throughout his whole life, he embraced the pain and limitations of being human; now, for our sake, he would take onto himself the final trial of death on a cross.

II: Do I accept the burdens, crosses and responsibilities of my life, or do I find little and sometimes big - ways to get around them?

All: Am I really willing to bear the cross of just being human, of always being dependent on my Creator? Do I thank God for what I have or grumble about what I lack? Am I a good steward of Creation itself, careful to protect the environment? For my lack of caring, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Third Station: Jesus Falls For the First Time

I: Under the weight of the cross, Jesus stumbles and falls hard to the ground. Despite the pain and growing weariness, he got up to continue on his way.

II: Do I get so discouraged by my failures that I want to give up? Do I try to force myself to be perfect and then hide my mistakes from others?

All: Have I forgotten that failure is an inevitable part of my life? Am I willing to pray to ask God for the courage I need to get up and try again? For the times I have slipped up, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Fourth Station: Jesus Meets Mary

I: As their eyes met, Jesus saw the anguish of Mary’s heart. He did not turn away, even though he could not take away her pain, even though he was part of the cause of her pain. Instead, he momentarily forgot his own suffering and tried to comfort her.

II: Am I willing to face my family and friends in their difficult times? Have I offered support to others or have I shielded myself from the sufferings around me?

All: Do I cherish my parents, giving them respect and carrying out my responsibilities toward them? For the times I’ve turned away, Lord have mercy

(Silent Reflection)

Fifth Station: Simon Is Forced To Carry Jesus’ Cross

I: Humiliated and physically exhausted. Jesus accepted Simon’s help.

II: Am I willing to accept the assistance of others with humility and gratitude, or do I resent the offer of help?

All: When I see someone else in need, do I reach out to them or ignore their plight? Am I careful to offer help without acting superior? For the times pride got in the way, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Sixth Station: Veronica Wipes The Face Of Jesus

I: Dripping with sweat and blood Jesus’ face showed the strain of his ordeal. Although it did not rescue him from his predicament, Veronica’s gesture brought him a moment of relief.

II: Am I willing to do what I can to ease someone else’s suffering, or will I give up if I can’t “fix” everything for them?

All: Do I try in small ways each day to be thoughtful of others, or have I been wrapped up lately in my own concerns? For my self-centeredness, Lord Have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Seventh Station: Jesus Falls A Second Time

I: Although Simon helped him and Veronica had just wiped his face for him, Jesus is overcome and stumbles again.

II: Have I taken good care of my own health? Do I treasure my sexuality as a gift from God not to be selfishly abused?

All: Am I careful to avoid those times and places I am tempted to repeat particular sins? For my cooperation with evil, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Eighth Station: Jesus Meets The Women Of Jerusalem

I: Jesus encounters a group of ritual mourners and bluntly tells them “Weep not for me, but for yourselves and your children.”

II: Am I willing to tell the truth whenever necessary, even though it may hurt?

All: Have my prayers and religious observances been genuine, and not just for show? For my insecurity, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Ninth Station: Jesus Falls A Third Time

I: The third Fall: suffering on top of suffering. Again the pain became unbearable and Jesus collapsed.

II: Has the presence of evil in the world led me to become cynical? Do I make fun of other people and their values?

All: Do I take my own faith for granted? Have I given regular attention to the praise and worship of God? For my lack of fidelity, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Tenth Station: Jesus Is Stripped Of His Clothing

I: As horrible as it is to imagine, Jesus’ clothing stuck to his open wounds. When they tore off his garments, knives of pain shot through his body.

II: Do I cling to my possessions, career, and friends, making them more important to me than Jesus?

All: Have I been honest in my acquisition of the goods I have? Am I willing to be completely dependent on God for what I need most? For the times I’ve put faith in idols, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Eleventh Station: Jesus Is Nailed To The Cross

I: The Roman soldiers could have tied Jesus to the cross, but instead they nailed his hands and feet. With hardened hearts, they gave little thought to their cruelty.

II: Have I grown callous to others in my speech and actions? Have I come to accept human cruelty, no longer even being outraged by torture and murder?

All: Do I engage in gossip about the misfortunes of others, or do I try to be a healing presence in the midst of tragedy? For my part in spreading pain, Lord Have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Twelfth Station: Jesus Dies On The Cross

I: Jesus hung lifeless on the cross, having poured out the last of his vitality. He held back nothing, counted nothing more important than doing the will of God the Father. And he did it for us.

II: Do I appreciate the life God has given me, or do I grow bitter with envy as I think about the possessions and relationships other people have?

All: Can I see areas in my life where I hold back from God? Can I ask for help to give my whole being to serve the Creator’s will? For my stubbornness, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

Thirteenth Station: Jesus Is Taken Off The Cross

I: Stunned by all they had witnessed, the disciples took Jesus’ lifeless body down from the cross so it might no longer be subject to violation and scorn.

II: Have I honored my promises and commitment?

All: Have I done my share to uphold human dignity, even when it is unpopular to do so? Do I value all human life regardless of age, sex, race and other qualities? For my boldness, Lord have mercy

(Silent Reflection)

Fourteenth Station: Jesus Is Laid In The Tomb

I: With the stone rolled across the tomb opening, all was silent, finished. Those who had conspired against Jesus thought they had won the day. Those who had followed him thought all was lost.

II: Am I willing to hope even when everything seems to be lost? Do I call upon God in the worst of times and offer thanks in the best?

All: Have I let Jesus into my heart and my actions? Do I practice the works of justice and mercy? For the hardness of my heart, Lord have mercy.

(Silent Reflection)

FINAL BLESSING AND INVITATION TO THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Presider: Jesus, your Way of the Cross brought you to the silence of the tomb, but we know that was not the end. We also know that our sinfulness and shortcomings are not the last word, either.
