- Execute scheduled and break-in maintenance on a variety of equipment including excavators, skid steers, generators, facilities, fleet trucks and trailers.
- Proficient and safe operation of heavy equipment, light vehicles, power tools, hand tools, and commercial truck/trailers.
- Follow and identify maintenance requirements on all vehicles, equipment, and tools
- Troubleshoot and Diagnose failures and deficiencies in the field or shop
