™ Create annual opportunities for prayer and reflection together as a fraternity. Under the guidance of their chaplain, councils can attend a retreat or day of reflection together or perhaps organize their own event for the men of their parish. Council participation in Spiritual Reflection is required to qualify for Columbian Award.

HELPING HANDS



The Helping Hands Program is designed to recognize the important work many councils already do to care for the most disadvantaged members of our communities – the homeless, the addicted, the elderly who may feel isolated and abandoned, and many others. Through this program, councils will aid the needy through the activities they feel best suit their community, such as serving at or running a soup kitchen, repairing the facilities of a local service organization or something entirely unique. The requirements for this program are very broad in order to allow councils to serve their community in whatever way is most need



Helping Hands

- 1.Contact leaders from local nonprofit organizations to discuss how the council and parish can best assist them in their work.

- 4. On the day of the event, wear Knights of Columbus-branded apparel and have the council membership director set up a table with brochures and membership documents (including Prospect Cards #921A). Do not forget that this event is a recruiting opportunity!
- 6. To gain credit for your program, complete the associated reporting forms and submit them to the Supreme Council Department of Fraternal Mission. Remember to retain copies for your council records.





NOVENA FOR LIFE

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The protection of life is a sustained prayer intention of the Church, and in particular of the Knights of Columbus. Knights remain firmly committed to defending the right to life of every human being – from the moment of conception to natural death. To commemorate and bolster this important cause, councils will promote a novena, nine days of sustained prayer, to build up a culture of life in our parishes, homes and wider community.



NOVENA FOR LIFE



- Working with your pastor, obtain his recommendations on conducting a Novena for Life.
- Set a date for the novena. Consider incorporating it as part of the council's participation in a 40 Days for Life campaign or schedule it to precede a major feast day or pro-life event.



NOVENA FOR LIFE

- ARIZONA PARIZONA PARI
- Anchor the beginning and end of the nine days with public church services like a Mass or rosary
- Consider organizing a social activity during the novena for the parish to come together and celebrate life
- Involve members of many parish organizations, especially the parish school and religious education leaders, in promoting and participating in the novena and services
- Order Prayer for Life Prayer Cards (#4665) through Supplies Online, the supply ordering portal available on Officers Online, and distribute them to members of the parish. Have these prayer cards available the week prior to the start of the novena, at the opening church service and at all associated activities. Also place a good supply of prayer cards in your church and council hall.

Holy Hour

- ™ Encourage deep personal encounter with God. Councils work with their pastors to organize a regular Holy Hour of Eucharistic adoration. A Knights of Columbus Holy Hour, prepared for the men of the parish, could include a reflection, communal rosary, prayers for intercession by Venerable Michael J. McGivney or St. Joseph, and various other aspects as decided by the council.
- The structure for a Holy Hour is broad and left to the discretion of your council. The primary objective is that all in attendance grow closer in faith with their brothers through a prayerful interaction with the Eucharist and with each other.

Sacramental Gifts

The sacraments stand as the most significant events in the life of the domestic church. The Knights of Columbus will be there to support and embrace our parish families at these essential moments of encounter with Christ. As children and adult members become more integrated into the life of the church and their parish, they should know that members of the Knights of Columbus will always be present in a tangible and meaningful way, regardless of who else is there for them.





Family Prayer Night

- Strengthen the bonds within our parishes and build faith-filled families. This is an opportunity for council members, their families, and the whole parish community to come together once a month for an evening of prayer, dinner, and fellowship.
- ™ Family Prayer Night is an opportunity for children to be exposed to regular people living their faith in a casual setting. Families of council members, as well as other Catholic families within the parish and community, will gather for prayer, dinner and fellowship. Multiple groups can be formed and families are encouraged to rotate between these groups.





Family Prayer Night

- A typical Family Prayer Night should ideally last between two and three hours, with guests leaving as needed.
- The schedule should include, but not be limited to:
 - Introductory period to meet the other families
 - Prayer in community
 - A fun activity such as a game
 - ∽ Meal and social time
 - Concluding prayer



Good Friday Family Promotion

Setting an example for their community, Knights will attend Good Friday services with their families and work with their pastors to encourage increased parishioner involvement at these liturgies. In conjunction with these efforts, councils will also work to educate their parishes about the plight of Christians in the Holy Land





Good Friday Family Promotion

- Ask council members to take direct action and encourage their family and friends to attend.
- Provide council members and the parish community a copy of Christ: Lord and Savior (#358) to help them contemplate who Jesus is and the sacrifices he made.
- Have the Christian Refugee Relief Prayer Cards (#10340) available in the parish and council hall to raise visibility of the issues affecting the Middle East.



Mass for People with Special Needs

- Welcome individuals or families who might not normally feel comfortable participating in a regularly scheduled Mass. Councils will sponsor a distinct Mass, conducted annually, for people with special needs.

- Determine who to invite by identifying people with special needs in the parish.
 - Special Olympics, The Arc, special education teachers Meals on Wheels, assisted-living facilities, group homes, senior citizen groups, disabled veterans organizations Health advocacy groups for Down syndrome, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, Lou Gehrig's disease, blindness or deafness



Pregnancy Center Support

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More than three thousand pro-life pregnancy centers now operate in jurisdictions throughout the Order. By the very nature of our founding, Knights of Columbus are called to care for the widow and orphan. Abortion-vulnerable unborn children and mothers experiencing unexpected pregnancies certainly fall within our mandate. With our aid, pregnancy centers can offer support to help them choose life. Councils can "adopt" a pregnancy center and provide material, labor, and spiritual support throughout the year.



Pregnancy Center Support

- Pray for nine months for an unborn child through a spiritual "adoption"

- Refer employment opportunities, affordable rental apartments, and opportunities for free or low-cost health care to the pregnancy center for client use
- Provide centers with funds for general expenses, purchase of a building, rental of an office, materials and labor for renovation, or for hiring or training of staff





Family of the Month

- Each month, hold a committee meeting to select the Family of the Month.
 To be selected as Family of the Month, each family should stand out as an exemplary model to others in the parish. They should meet the following criteria:
 - Is the family tight-knit?
 - Ones the family spend quality time together?
 - Os Does the family attend weekly Mass together?
 - Os Does the family pray together outside of Mass?
 - Has the family made significant contributions to the parish and church community?
 - Obes the family serve as a model of Catholic family values?



CHRISTMAS POSTER CONTEST

- Order the program kit (#CPC-Kit)
- The council's Community director, in consultation with the grand knight, should select a team that will administer the contest.
- Contact all schools, both public and private, in your community to publicize your contest. Solicit the support of the teachers and administrators; ask them to encourage their students to participate or to consider using the contest as a project for art classes. Each entry should be the work of an individual student.
- If there are multiple schools participating, consider conducting preliminary judging. In this way, the people in the community that you ask to serve as judges, which should include young people, will not be overburdened with a volume of posters, and the judging process will proceed more quickly.
- Display promotional materials prominently. The posters included in the Poster Contest kit should be displayed in any school from which students would participate.
- Recognize everyone participating by presenting participation certificates to all who submit entries, and council champion certificates to your council's winners. Encourage each school to develop some type of recognition for the winning entries in that particular school.

The <u>FIRST requirement</u> of our safe environment program is for our members to be aware of, and compliant with, arch/diocesan safe environment requirements applicable to members' volunteer activities on parish property.

Procedure For Compliance with Arch/diocesan Safe Environment Requirements

ARIZONA POR SOLUTION AND SOLUTI

Grand knights and financial secretaries of parish based councils should:

- 1. Make a list of all members who serve as volunteers on parish property which shall be referred to as the "ELIGIBLE MEMBER VOLUNTEER LIST."
- 2. Ask each member on the list whether he has already completed the arch/diocesan safe environment training and background screening.
- 3. If the member volunteer has already completed such training, then a "check" should be placed next to the member's name.
- 4. If the member volunteer has NOT completed the arch/diocesan safe environment requirements, the member volunteer must complete those requirements as soon as possible to ensure eligibility to continue to volunteer on parish property.
- 5. The Grand Knight should be prepared to provide the ELIGIBLE MEMBER VOLUNTEER LIST to the parish priest, the parish safe environment liaison, and to the arch/diocesan safe environment coordinator upon request.
- 6. The ELIGIBLE MEMBER VOLUNTEER LIST should be continually updated with any new member volunteers who wish to become eligible to volunteer on parish property.
- 7. The Grand Knight should be sure to always provide the updated ELIGIBLE MEMBER VOLUNTEER LIST to the parish priest, the parish safe environment liaison, and to the arch/diocesan safe environment coordinator upon request.



COUNCIL DIRECTORS - If members in Director roles have not satisfied their requirements within **30 days of notification**, they will be **removed** from their position. Grand Knights will be required to appoint a different member who will go through the same process.

Compliance Troubleshooting

Common Misunderstandings

- Member email addresses are taken from the Form 185, the Form 365, and the Form 468.
- Members in these roles should look for email notifications from Praesidium in their inbox or spam folder.
- If members in these roles do not receive an email from Praesidium by September 1st, it may be that they either do not have an email on file with the Knights of Columbus or their council has not yet updated its rosters to indicate members' new role assignments.
- The recipient must complete the training and background check authorization within **thirty (30) days** of notification.
- Knights of Columbus covers all costs associated with these requirements.

- Overall, the Arizona jurisdiction grew and is much stronger in the 2017-2018 fraternal year.







Overview

- The Shepherd Program is implemented to help new knights feel welcome in our council, meet other members, develop the interests in our programs, and have them become involved with our activities. All of which generates enthusiasm and improves retention.
- Each new member of the council is assigned a Shepherd, a current member, to mentor the new brother on their journey.
- This mentoring phase may vary but typically will last around three months.
- Members will be graduated from the Shepherd program when they are comfortable with the council and are involved with an activity.

Milestones

Along the way, the Shepherd will track milestones such as the ones listed below:



- Meet with our council's insurance representative.
- Attend three (3) council meeting
- Participate in three (3) council events
- Recruit one (1) new member

Strengthen Involvement

The Shepherd will work with the new brother to strengthen their relationship to their new brothers by doing the following:

- Real Ensure their new brother's attendance.
- Sit with the new member and introduce them to the other members especially the Council Officers.
- Answer any questions they may have regarding the Knights of Columbus or our activities, our parish, and ministries involved in our programs.
- Shepherds will encourage their new member to become involved in our events like the pancake breakfast, Lent Fish Fry, etc. throughout the season.

Entering The Program

- When a candidate's application for membership is read, a Shepherd is assigned to that member and will attend their First Degree.
 - ☑ If the new member is a transfer, a Shepherd is assigned at the earliest opportunity.
- The Shepherd works with their new brother to complete an online New Member Information form.
 - This form collects updated e-mail address, spouse information, and them to select three (3) council activities that they might be interested in.
 - This form is sent to the Program Directors for the aforementioned selected activities.
