District Awards



The **New Council Award** is presented to those district deputies responsible for the development of a new council.

A The Star District Award is presented to those district deputies who attain 100 percent or more of the district membership net gain quota and the district insurance net gain quota and have at least one of the councils in the district earn one of the levels of the Star Council Award.

A The All Star District Award is presented to those district deputies who attain the Star District Award and have all of their active councils earn the Star Council Award. Must have a minimum of three active councils to be All Star and only available in insurance territories.

Council Awards

Rather McGivney Award

- Recognizes excellence in council membership growth
- Supreme Council assigns a membership quota for each council
- Council Membership Growth is considered to be net increase over losses through suspension or withdrawal. Deaths and transfers in and out do not count against quota.

Real Founders' Award

- Recognizes excellence in the promotion of our insurance and fraternal benefits
- Growth is considered to be net gain above losses through suspensions, withdrawals and transfers from insurance to associate membership

Real Columbian Award

• Recognizes a council's charitable service activities and fraternal programs in each of **four** Faith in Action categories (Faith, Community, Family, Life)
