Map of COAD/VOAD locations as of September 2018



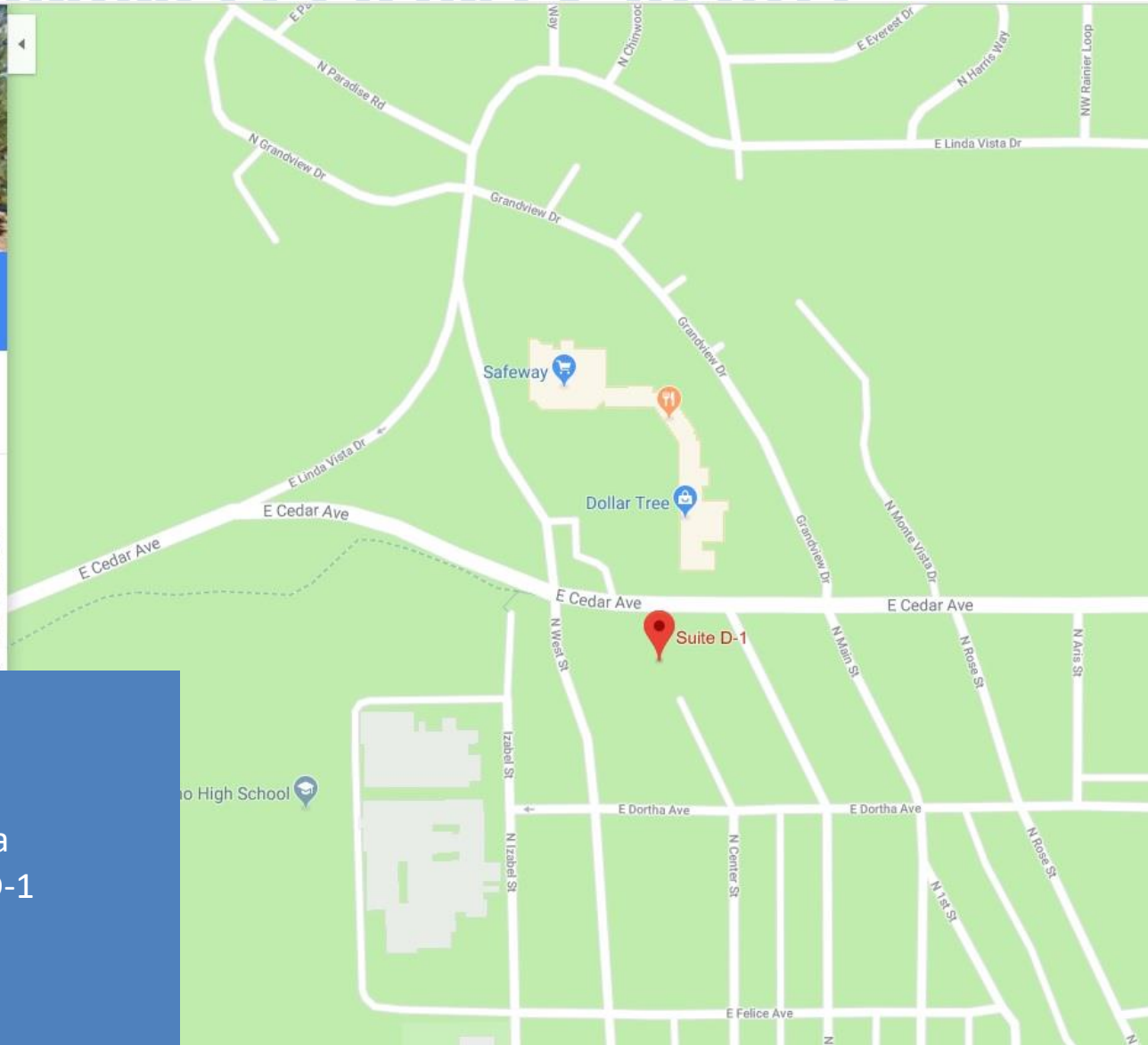
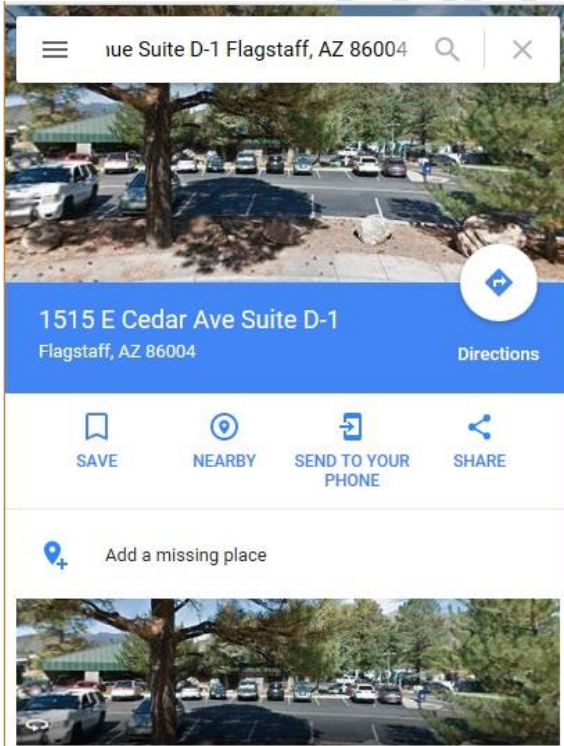
Currently there are six locations (with more being developed) where the Community Organizations and Emergency Managers convene regularly to discuss disaster response and recovery within their communities.

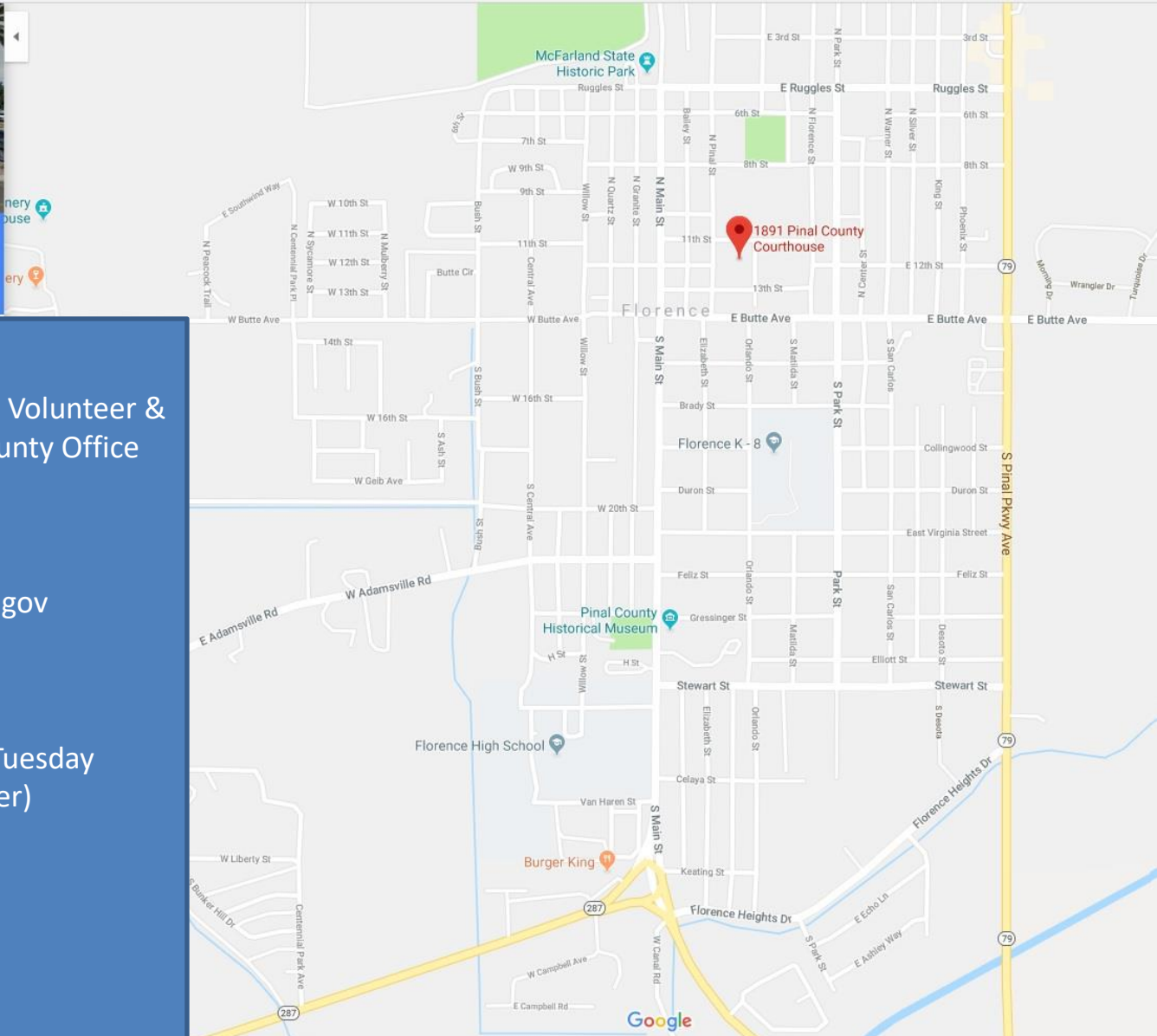

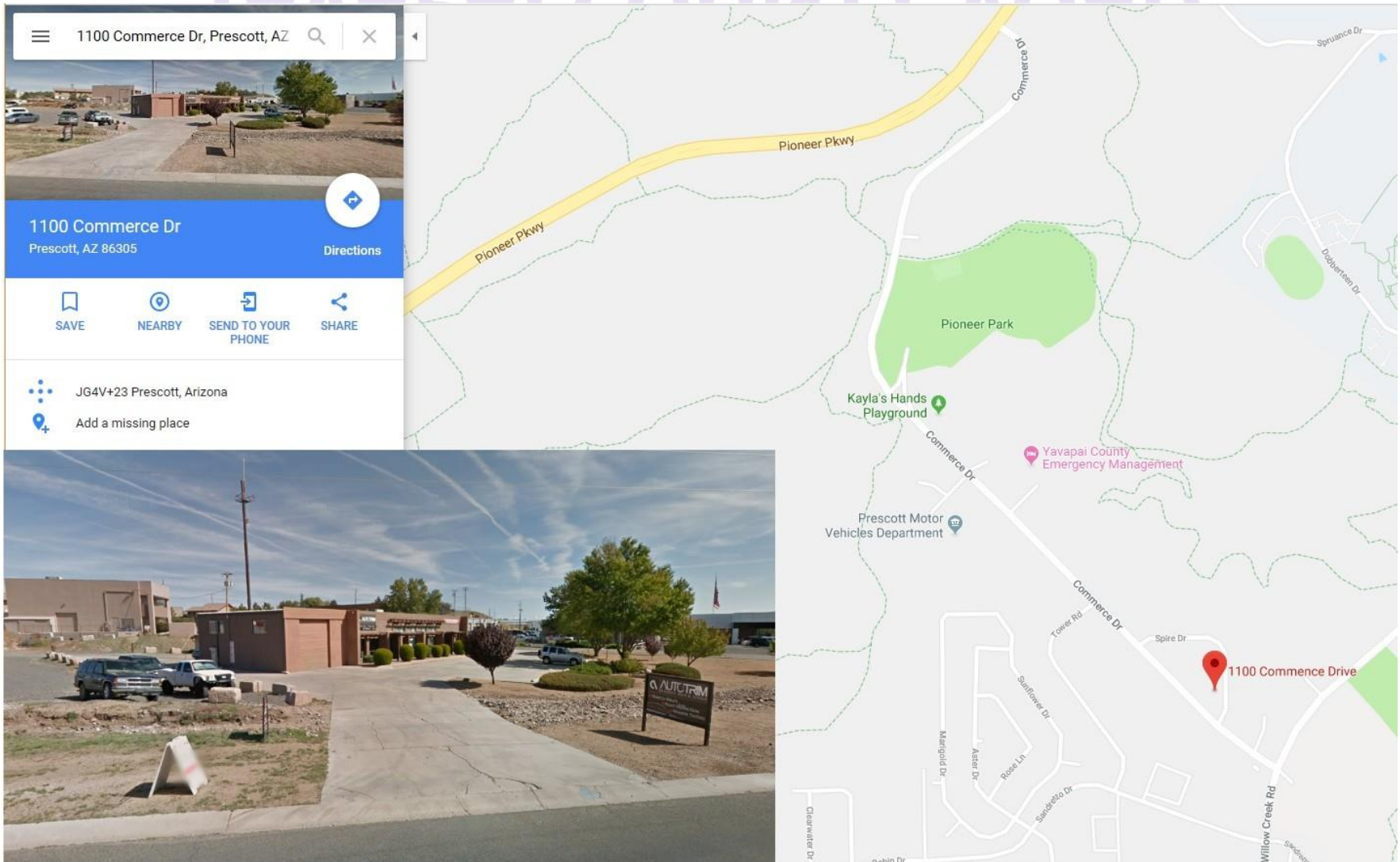
