## BOARD SUSPENSION OF MEMBERS BECAUSE OF SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

- All members of the Knights of Columbus are held to the same standards of conduct under the Laws of the Order regardless of whether they are lay persons or clergy.
- Any misconduct that would cause a member of the Knights of Columbus to lose his membership would apply equally to clergy.
- Regarding the Honorary Life status of priests and bishops, misconduct of any kind that would cause a member to be suspended from the Knights of Columbus under the Laws of the Order would also result in the revocation of any Honorary Life Membership.
- Any specific concern about a particular member of the Knights of Columbus should be referred to the Knights of Columbus Office of Youth Protection at oyp@kofc.org for review.
