#### Faithful Friar's Message

Greetings brother Knights. As we head into the New Year, it is a common tradition to make a New Year's resolution. Recall that on the Sunday after Christmas, we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Family. I would like to invite us to be resolved to imitate them this New Year. Our Holy Father Francis wrote in his exhortation that family is "where we learn to live with others despite our differences...."

St. Paul, in his letter to the Colossians (3:12-21), gives us some practical ways we can live with our family "despite our differences." This includes compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, bearing with one another, and forgiveness. In addition, Paul says that we must realize that when we share a home, we not only have to forgive others, but are in need of others' forgiveness as well.

Family life offers a wonderful opportunity to put into practice our life of faith. It is in the mundane and ordinary aspects of our lives where our faith life and family life can intersect. Sacred moments happen around the dinner table, in working on a project together, as well as praying and going to Mass together. There are also many opportunities to forgive one another for the little things - like not replacing the milk in the refrigerator, not putting out a new roll of paper towels, or forgetting to fill the tank with gas.

Remember, being a holy family was not a given for Mary and Joseph. It did not just happen to them. They had to work at it. From the beginning, Mary and Joseph had to learn to compromise and to sacrifice.
