2026 State Raffle Sales Sheet

Basic Raffle Information

- 10 cash prizes - \$10,000, \$7,000, \$5000, \$3000, \$2000, \$1000 and 4 - \$500
- Drawing at State Convention banquet on Saturday May 2nd, 2026.
Winners do not need to be present to win
- Ticket Donation Amounts
 - 6 books of tickets for \$100
 - Book of 5 tickets for \$20
 - \$5 per ticket.
- Purchase of tickets is NOT considered tax deductible.

Where does the money go?

- 50% of the ticket sales is being donated to 501c3 charities that have been chosen by our council.
This year those are: _____.
- The other 50% goes to the State K of C council. After they deduct the cost for the raffle prizes and the ticket printing costs, they make charitable donations on behalf of all our councils in the State.

Winner Eligibility

- At the State Convention, ten raffle tickets are drawn beginning with the 1st prize through the 10th prize. Two alternate tickets are drawn to be used if a winner is disqualified or cannot be contacted. If a winner is disqualified or cannot be contacted, winners below them will move up one place and the 1st alternate will be added to the 10th place position. If needed, the process is repeated using the 2nd alternate name. The State Raffle Chairman will use all reasonable means to contact a winner with the information provided on the winning ticket. If no contact is made within 30 days, that winner will be removed
- Prizes are payable only to the name on the raffle ticket stub.
- Winners must be 21 years or older to purchase tickets and collect prize.
- Raffle winners are responsible for all State and Federal taxes unless a backup withholding is allowed.
- Any person winning \$600 or more is required to provide a completed IRS W-9 Form with a valid Taxpayer Identification
- Number (TIN) prior to receiving the prize. This must occur within 30 days of being notified. Failure to do so will result in the person being disqualified. The only exception to providing a completed IRS W-9 Form is that if a TIN is not available, the winner may be allowed to provide Backup Withholding of 24% of the winning amount to the Arizona Knights of Columbus Charities Inc. This 24% will be withheld from the payment to the winner and paid to the IRS to cover the required federal tax on the winnings.
