- Councils participated in Eucharistic Procession for Christ the King!

- We are 5 months into the year and 57 councils have not recruited one member into the council. Out of those, 43 have men in the Prospect Tab!!! If you do not know how to contact these men, please talk with our Online Membership Director Jim Walsh at <u>Jim.Walsh.KofC.DistrictDeputy@gmail.com</u> on how to get these men through a C-U-F Degree and into your council!
- Speaking of prospect tab, 35 councils could achieve their membership quota for the year if they brought those members in through a C-U-F. The longer a man sits on the prospect tab, the more likely you are to lose him! Engage with him as soon as possible! Schedule a C-U-F degree and engage with them to join you for it!
- I've participated on some of the church drives and some councils and found some flyers that were a bit old. Please be sure to read the Membership portion of this advisory to find out what and how to order the new material. Most of these are free and you pay for shipping only.
- And it continues: Spoof emails! As with the last few months, there has been a lot of "spoof" emails that look like they are coming from me. If you receive one, the first thing to do is check the "From" full address (see below as example).

## 'Tis the Season: FOR RECRUITING!!!!!!!!

Brothers, you continue to amaze us with your efforts to bring more Catholic men into the Order!! Here are some of the highlights:

- 9 Councils Have Already Achieved Supreme Membership Goal for 2024-2025
- > 2 Councils Have Already Achieved Double Star Membership Goal!
- > 5 Councils Are Only 1 or 2 members away from their goal for the year!
- Many Councils Have Enough Prospects to reach membership goal but need to hold a C-U-F Degree to get membership credit

We still have a **HUGE** number of prospects waiting to take their C-U-F and transfer into local councils. It is vital that councils schedule C-U-F Degrees regularly (at least once a month), and that the GK, FinSec, or Membership Director personally contact EVERY man on your council's prospect list and invite them to the C-U-F with their families. All too often, councils are waiting way too long to hold a C-U-F Ceremony, and by the time they do, the prospect has lost interest. We need to strike while the iron is hot to get new members through the C-U-F and into your councils as soon as possible!

## What Is Your Membership "Goal"??

The great thing about travelling around the state assisting at Church Drives is that I get to meet a lot of Brother Knights and talk to them about the challenges their councils face when recruiting men to join. During these conversations, I have found that many councils still are hesitant to break from the old way of recruiting and embrace the new K of C world we live in. Some examples:

- 1) Using Paper Form 100's for All New Members
- 2) Striving to Meet the Supreme New Member Goal for the Fr. McGivney Award
- 3) Only Trying to Recruit Candidates Deemed "Worthy" By the Council

Let me address these examples one at a time:

1) We need to embrace technology as much as possible when recruiting and signing up new members. Paper Form 100's take longer to process, and many times get lost or damaged before they can be submitted. We should

be signing each member up using the "Join" feature on the K of C website. Cell phones, tablets, and/or a computer should be present at all recruiting events. This way, the prospect's information is captured and sent directly to the GK and FinSec via Officers On-Line. Technology is not going away. We need to adapt accordingly.

- 2) Many times, I'll ask council officers "What is your recruiting goal?", and the most common answer I get is the membership goal or "quota" that Supreme has set for the council to earn the Fr. McGivney and Star Council Awards. While admirable, our goal as Knights <u>should always be to have</u> <u>EVERY Catholic man join!</u>
- 3) This point directly dovetails off example #2. It is our duty as Knights to share the gift of membership with as many Catholic men as we can, not just a select few that someone in the council has chosen. To quote Past Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, "It is our moral obligation to invite every eligible Catholic man to join the Knights of Columbus." The two key words are "ELIGIBLE" and "EVERY". When recruiting, we always want to make sure the candidate answers yes to being 18 years old and a Baptized, Practical Catholic. If they confirm these (as they are required to on both the on-line application and Form 100), they should be welcomed into the Order and the Council. Period. We no longer do candidate interviews to determine if a man should be allowed to join. Should an issue of his religious eligibility arises, we refer that matter to our Council Chaplain or Pastor for guidance.

## Out With The Old, In With The New!!!!

As we get ready to ring in the New Year, it's time for a lot of councils to clean out their old recruiting materials and order the latest versions available on the K of C website. Many councils are still handing out brochures that have been redone 2 and 3 times since they were originally ordered. If you want to see hold old your stock is, just look on the back page of any K of C brochure in the bottom right-hand corner. Each pamphlet will show the item number, followed by a month/year that it was printed (6/18 would be June of 2018 as an example). I guarantee that almost every council has brochures that are at least 10 years old (and some older)!!







There is an easy fix to this problem: Order New Materials and throw away the old!!!! GK's and FS's: Log into Officers Online and click on Supplies Online



And best of all, most of them are FREE (aside from a few dollars for shipping). Here are a few of the most common brochures that assist when recruiting. If there is a cost, I have that listed as well. Make that New Year's Resolution to start fresh in 2025 with all new membership materials both in English and Spanish!

## Church Membership Drive Playbook

## 2-3 Weeks Prior

- > Post dates of church drive on state calendar
- Run ads in church bulletin every week
- Organize teams of 6-8 brother knights for each mass
- Invite the Field Agent to help out
- Ask pastor/priests to promote the knights and encourage men to join

## Day Of Event

- Greet parishioners before each mass
- > Hand out K of C info to men and prayers cards to the ladies & children

With Pastor's permission, give a 2-3 minute pulpit speech (note: have your best speaker do it, not always the GK)

Conclude pulpit announcement by reciting prayer on prayer card handed out (members distribute more during speech)

- Cover all exits after mass. Greet everyone but identify men that might be interested
- > Funnel prospects to the "closers" on your team. Have agent code and team membership numbers available.

Assist candidates with completing on-line membership <u>and</u> have candidate confirm while standing there

Congratulate and welcome your new brother knight (and his family) with a smile and firm handshake!!

## The Following Sunday

- Host A C-U-F Degree Ceremony immediately after the last mass of the day
- Have The Ceremony in the church, of possible

Host a luncheon/desserts & coffee/social event immediately after ceremony ends. This will give you a chance to meet and learn about the new member and allow him to meet and greet his new brother knights!

- > Ask new brothers to introduce themselves and their families before eating
- > Have FinSec hand out membership cards before new members depart

We are finding that by following this playbook (with modifications unique to each council), we are having more success at not only getting members to join, but also getting them engaged early, providing the council with an influx of active members looking for programs to participate in.



#### Faith Transforms Culture – The Design

The Eucharist is the center of the state. We need to keep Christ at the center of everything we do.

The word "Transforms" extends out from the Eucharist and wraps around the state. This transformation happens internally in each one of us so that we can transform those we encounter.

The rays coming from the Eucharist are symbolic of the colors of the State of Arizona.

- The Gold is the color of Jesus' Divinity. He is True God.
- The Red is the color of Jesus' blood: He is truly Human.

Blue is the color of Mary. We need to ask for Mary's intercession to her Son by praying the Rosary often.



The baby feet are white to signify the pure innocence lost with every abortion that occurs. We will continue to support Life from Conception to Natural Death.
