Greetings, Brothers All!

It's hard to believe that we are starting a new fraternal year! I have a few reminders for you:

- Your Supreme Per Capita bill has or should arrive soon. Make sure to pay this promptly to keep your council in good standing with Supreme.
- You will receive your First Half State Per Capita billing soon. It will be e-mailed to the Financial Secretary and Grand Knight. State Per capita is how the State Council's work is funded. Please pay this bill promptly. You get a rebate credit if you pay the bill within a month of the billing date. The assessment is \$5.50 per billable member per half. Inactive members are \$2.25 per half. Honorary Life and Disabled members are not charged. Disabled members must be defined through Form 1831 with Supreme. Billing is based on Council Membership as of July 1. Thank you!
- Per Capita payments do not require a council vote.
- If you have not done so, make sure you deposit your council Per Diem check from the State Convention. Checks older than 6 months will be voided.
- Also, please make sure you have given your Charity Raffle Checks to your chosen Charities. Encourage them to deposit them as soon as possible and remind them that checks older than 6 months will be voided. Each year a few checks are never cashed. Let's make sure our Charities get the funds they deserve.

We're all looking forward to a successful fraternal year and are eager to get to work. I'm sure we're excited to show Arizona that our Faith can truly Transform our Culture.

With the start of a new Fraternal Year, it is time to talk about Supreme Form 185, Form 365, the State Directory and Supreme Compliance. The information below is a step-by-step process for these forms and requirements. If your council has not submitted these required forms, please do so today. If you need assistance or have questions, you can contact your District Deputy, myself, or any State Officer. Completing these forms and requirements will set your council up for a successful year.

Council Officers Form 185

- The Financial Secretary should use Officer Online – Member Management – Council Administration - Council Officers
- It should be submitted no later than June 30, 2024.
- Every position on this form does not need to be filled.
- A GK is required, other than that send in what you have and send in an update when additional positions are filled.
- Send copy to ses@kofc-az.org

Service Program Personnel Form 365

- The Financial Secretary should use Officer Online – Member Management – Council Administration - Service Program Personnel
- It should be submitted no later than June 30, 2024.
- Every position on this form does not need to be filled.
- Assign someone to the "**Insurance Promotion**" role. This is the person who should be coordinating a Fraternal Benefits Event with the agent and sending out the invitations for members and nonmembers to attend (*Hint: Talk to the parish office to invite other ministries of the church to attend!!!*)
- The **Grand Knight, Program, Community, and Family** Directors are required to do online training.
- Community and Family Directors must also do background.



- The Grand Knight may fill one of the other three positions if necessary
- A council can send an incomplete form and send in an update when additional positions are filled.
- Send copy to ses@kofc-az.org

State Directory Form

- <https://www.cognitofrms.com/StateWebArizona/DirectoryInformation>
- Should be submitted no later than August 1, 2024.
- Every position on this form does not need to be filled.
- The GK or FS should complete this form.
- This information is used to contact knights and inform the council through Flocknote.

Safe Environment Compliance

- Should be completed no later than September 1, 2024.
- Supreme Safe Environment Training and Diocese Safe Environment Training are separate trainings. Also, all 3 dioceses have different trainings.
- Completing one does not fulfill any of the requirements for another.
- Council Knights in key leadership roles are required to complete Supreme Safe Environment Training through Praesidium Academy. This includes GK, FN, Program, Family, and Community Directors.
- The Supreme Safe Environment Training is initiated when Forms 185 and 365 are submitted to Supreme. The GK, Program, Community, and Family Directors will receive an email with instructions on how to complete the Praesidium Academy training.
- Once the instruction email is sent, the link will expire if not completed in 45 days. If that happens a new 365 needs to be sent to start the process over again.
- Any knight that may have contact on **diocese** property with children or vulnerable adults must complete **diocese** training.

- Do *not* assign a man to a position that requires training that he is not willing to complete. The GK should have this conversation before sending the 185 or 365.
- Contact Worthy State Advocate Bobby Nielsen if you are having issues with a man reluctant to complete training.

Greetings gentlemen,

As the new life director, I am committed to help with your council's Life Programs and make them successful. Just drop me a note and can discuss ways you or your council can get involved in supporting Life in AZ.

We have a big battle ahead of us through November. There is a petition going around to get an initiative on the ballot this November that will enshrine abortion into Arizona's Constitution. Our God through our Catholic Faith tells us abortion is an intrinsic evil and that there is no room for compromise on this basic Truth. We must stand together and step into the breach to first keep this off the ballot and then apply our faith when it comes time to vote if it makes it onto the ballot. The petition gatherers are being very sneaky about how they get people to sign, so be wary of any petition gatherers and make sure to read what you are signing. Please **DECLINE TO SIGN** the abortion initiative. Always be wary as the abortion industry is very persistent and if we beat them this time they will be back again and again.



Please make sure to educate yourself on what this initiative does as it removes all constraints on the abortion industry and allows.

- No requirement for a medical doctor to be present, perform or oversee an abortion
- Abortion up to birth
- Abortion for a minor with no parental knowledge or consent
- Abortion funded by taxpayers

1. **Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP):** Adopt a pregnancy center and support them. Supreme will add \$100 for every \$500 up to \$2000 per center you support. <https://www.kofc.org/en/contact/asap.html>
2. **Walking With Moms In Need (WWMIN):** This is a Diocesan program by the USCCB that you can get involved in to increase the Church's outreach and assistance to pregnant and parenting women in need. Let women know that we have a list of resources available to help them find the support they need and will walk with them through this process. Let them know that they are never alone. For more information go to <https://dphx.org/walking-with-moms-in-need/> and <https://www.usccb.org/prolife/walking-moms-need>.
3. **40 Days for Life:** This organization marches prays in front of abortion clinics to show women there is an alternative to abortion and help in their despair and fear. The next 40 day period kicks off Sept 5th.

4. **Ultrasound Initiative:** This program raises money to purchase ultrasound machines for Crisis Pregnancy Centers in AZ. Every dollar you raise is matched by Supreme. The State Council purchases annually about three machines. These machines are expensive and know your council does not need to raise all the money for a machine. Do what you can and the State Council pools the donations to make the purchases with the approved centers. Make checks out to AZ Knights of Columbus Charity Inc. Put Ultrasound in the memo line and send to Dominic Conn, 606 E Broadmor Dr, Tempe, AZ 85282.

There are many opportunities you can take to make a difference in supporting Life in AZ. The key is to get involved, pick a program and do it. Most importantly we all must pray to Mary and Jesus to intercede for us to change the hearts and minds of first those who are so in despair that they might seek an abortion and second to those who are so callous that they would be involved in performing and supporting this evil. We must not stand by idle while this industry destroys the gift of Life and the future of humanity, our children.

Faith Transforms Culture – The Design

The Eucharist is the center of the state. We need to keep Christ at the center of everything we do.

The word “Transforms” extends out from the Eucharist and wraps around the state. This transformation happens internally in each one of us so that we can transform those we encounter.

The rays coming from the Eucharist are symbolic of the colors of the State of Arizona.

- The Gold is the color of Jesus' Divinity. He is True God.
- The Red is the color of Jesus' blood: He is truly Human.

Blue is the color of Mary. We need to ask for Mary’s intercession to her Son by praying the Rosary often.

The baby feet are white to signify the pure innocence lost with every abortion that occurs. We will continue to support Life from Conception to Natural Death.
