Greetings, Brothers All!

Here's my final newsletter message as your State Secretary. The time has sure flown by! Congratulations to all on a most successful year in membership, programs, and faith.

On behalf of the State Council, I'd like to sincerely thank the councils that have made their second-half per capita payments.

We have mailed the state convention per diem checks. Council checks were mailed to Supreme's Financial Secretary of record for your council. District Deputy checks were sent directly to the DDs. Please deposit these checks as soon as possible.

We have also mailed the State Charity Raffle checks for council donations. Checks for individual council charities were mailed to Supreme's Financial Secretary of record for your council. Multiple checks will arrive in the same envelope. When multiple council donations were made to the same Charity, like Saint Joseph Youth Camp or Special Olympics, the donations were combined, and a check was sent directly to the Charity. Please present your checks to your charities as soon as possible. Make it a photo opportunity! Present donations to your Parish in a public setting! Encourage your charities to deposit the checks as soon as they can. Every year a few charity checks are never cashed and are voided after 6 months. Your charities deserve those funds. Make sure they get them!

If you are expecting a per diem check or State Raffle charity checks and have not received them, please check with your Financial Secretary. By now they should have all arrived in the mail. Send an email to Worthy State Treasurer Larry Powers if the checks are still missing.

I am encouraged to see that our Jurisdiction is "running through the tape" and finishing strong in membership and programs. Make sure you submit your Columbian Award (SP-7) reports as soon as you can so if there are problems they can be corrected before the end of June.

Remember that the State first half per capita and your Supreme assessments are based on your billable council membership on July 1. If you are working on







transferring members to the Affiliate Program, complete that work as soon as possible so that your roster is ready for the next fraternal year.

They are the winner of the \$150 Global Wheelchair Mission donation. Along with 15 other councils, they participated in Holy Hours, Adoration, and Eucharistic Processions on Holy Thursday. May numbers will be posted at the end of the month, and I will announce the winner for the featured Rosary Programs, Holy Hours, and May Crownings. On May 31st, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast commemorates the Blessed Mother's visit to her cousin Elizabeth and the encounter of Jesus and St. John the Baptist while in the wombs of their mothers. We are going to do it again, and on Friday, June 27, is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Please contact DD Bryant Sayers now to reserve the Icon. Present it during a Holy Hour or Sunday masses in June. Many Pastors have Eucharistic Processions annually for the Solemnity mass.

Brother Knight, Dave Kasper of St. Anne's Council in Gilbert, AZ, and his wife Carol started the Luggage for Foster Kids Program about 3 years ago. Two years ago, the program was presented at the Mid-Year K of C Meeting and received unanimous approval to go statewide. The Kaspers would like to see this Program go statewide. Please see the photos of their last pickup. The previous pickup was the day before Thanksgiving. The pickups are done by partners of OCJ Kids. They partner with Foster groups and distribute throughout the state of Arizona. The program costs nothing and is easy to manage. Knights within West Valley make pickups out west and in Scottsdale. There is now the possibility of a Tucson Council collecting luggage. This is a definite way to bring dignity and self-esteem to a difficult situation with children taken into Foster Care. To date, the Program has collected and distributed approximately 2000 gently used Suitcases and 1000 Backpacks.

The Kaspers can coordinate the pickup/Delivery of Suitcases with their partners at OCJ Kids and then distribute them to the Foster Children. If you do not have a Foster Children program in your area, please contact Catholic Community Services or the Diocese of Phoenix and Tucson for guidance.

On behalf of the State Officers, as well as the State Membership Team, we want to thank you all for your tremendous efforts this year to invite men into the Order. With only a month left in the Fraternal Year, we want to focus on getting every council to their goal so they can be recognized as Star/Double Star/Triple Star Council, etc. We have so many councils that are only 1 or 2 new members away from reaching the next level goal!!!! Here's our suggestions to help put your councils over the top:

- If you don't have enough Prospects on your council's page, host a Church Drive between now and June 22nd.
- 2) Host a C-U-F Ceremony soon after your Church Drive, or as soon as possible if you have men on your Prospect Tab. Call, text, and email EVERY Prospect on your list and invite them (and their families) to attend.
- 3) Using Officers Online, transfer your Prospects into your council the same day you hold the C-U-F Ceremony (but no later than June 25th).
- 4) Avoid using paper Form 100's!! Enter new candidates using the E-Membership web site. Using paper Form 100's will delay these men being assigned to your council, and you may miss out on hitting your goals due to a paperwork backlog!!!

Remember, the Fraternal Year ends on Monday, June 30th. Supreme is on Eastern time. It is highly unlikely that any men processed the last weekend of the month will be added to your roster by the close of business on June 30th. Please be proactive and get everyone processed by June 25th to allow Supreme enough time!!!!

The State Team is here to help you with your last-minute Church Drives and C-U-F Ceremonies. Please let us know how we can help all your councils shine like STARS!!!!

Thanks again for your extraordinary efforts in recruiting this year. Your hard work is paying huge dividends for your councils!

Church Membership Drive Playbook

2-3 Weeks Prior

- > Post dates of church drive on state calendar
- Run ads in church bulletin every week
- Organize teams of 6-8 brother knights for each mass
- Invite the Field Agent to help out
- Ask pastor/priests to promote the knights and encourage men to join

Day Of Event

- Greet parishioners before each mass
- > Hand out K of C info to men and prayers cards to the ladies & children
- ➢ With Pastor's permission, give a 2-3 minute pulpit speech (note: have your best speaker do it, not always the GK)

Conclude pulpit announcement by reciting prayer on prayer card handed out (members distribute more during speech)

Cover all exits after mass. Greet everyone but identify men that might be interested

➢ Funnel prospects to the "closers" on your team. Have agent code and team membership numbers available.

Assist candidates with completing on-line membership <u>and</u> have candidate confirm while standing there

Congratulate and welcome your new brother knight (and his family) with a smile and firm handshake!!

The Following Sunday

- Host A C-U-F Degree Ceremony immediately after the last mass of the day
- Have The Ceremony in the church, of possible
- Host a luncheon/desserts & coffee/social event immediately after ceremony ends.

This will give you a chance to meet and learn about the new member and allow him to meet and greet his new brother knights!

- > Ask new brothers to introduce themselves and their families before eating
- > Have FinSec hand out membership cards before new members depart

We are finding that by following this playbook (with modifications unique to each council), we are having more success at not only getting members to join, but also getting them engaged early, providing the council with an influx of active members looking for programs to participate in.

Faith Transforms Culture – The Design
