The timing of the resolution occurs at the start of the new year, but it doesn't mean it's too late to start.

We had a great January from a recruitment side of things, bringing more men into the order than we have in the previous 10+ Januarys! The only way that works is through hosting Church Drives. The Playbook that has been in all the newsletters works.

But don't stop at just signing them up online, get them through a CUF Degree within 2 weeks of hosting the drive! Get them into your council to help you with your activities so we can bring them closer to Christ.

When asked, is it about the numbers? The answer is yes: it is about asking all eligible men to join us so they can build and strengthen their relationship with Jesus. If we don't share what we do as Knights and offer that to every man, how can we build of that kingdom of God here on earth?

By now, you should have filed your Form 1728, the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activities. This is a required form for Star Council. If you haven't filed, you can still do so. Make sure you complete this as soon as possible. As of February 5, less than half of the councils have filed this form. (Hint: If you have filled out the 10784's over the past year, you would be able to calculate those numbers easily!)

The next one coming up is the 1295 Semiannual Council Audit due February 15. Please send copies to ses@kofc-az.org.

So why do we talk Star Council all the time? Is it about recognition for the Grand Knight? The answer I hear a lot is "I'm not in it for the recognition." To be quite frank, that is a selfish response.

What about your council members who performed all the programs and hard work throughout the year?

Greetings, Brothers All! It's hard to believe that we are already halfway through the fraternal year!

- You will receive your Second Half State Per Capita statement In Early February. It will be emailed to the Financial Secretary of record with Supreme and to the Grand Knight. If you are the former holder of these roles, and receive the email, please forward it to your successor. State Per Capita is how the State Council's work is funded. Please pay this bill promptly. You get a rebate credit if you pay the bill within a month of the billing date. The assessment is \$5.50 per billable member per half. Inactive members are \$2.25 per half. Honorary Life and Disabled members are not charged. Disabled members must be defined through Form 1831 with Supreme. Billing is based on the Supreme record of Council Membership as of January 1.
- Optional donations to the Navarrete Vocations Fund and to St. Joesph Youth Camp are also accepted.
- If you did not pay your First Half Per Capita, that balance will be included in the Second Half statement.
- Remember, Delegates from Councils that are not current on their Per Capita will not be seated at the State Convention.
- Per Capita payments do not require a council vote.

We're all working hard for a successful fraternal year. We're growing membership and conducting exciting programs. I'm sure we're excited to show Arizona that our Faith can truly Transform our Culture.

Worthy Grand Knights,

There are many responsibilities that come with the position of Grand Knight. Although you may not be responsible for completing all tasks, you are responsible to make sure they are completed. I would like to review 3 areas I have found councils have problems with in the past.

Council Liability Insurance

The Supreme Council requires all Councils to carry general liability insurance. Many dioceses and parishes also require proof of insurance when using their space for events. Your council is free to use whatever company they choose. Many use Lockton Affinity, they specialize in providing insurance for Knights of Columbus Councils. They can be reached at 800 496-0288. Supreme and State Brand Assets

Look at your council websites and publications to confirm you are using the current emblem of the Order.

There were significant changes in the made Emblem in 2020

Subordinate councils, assembly's, chapters and their members are permitted to use Supreme and Arizona Jurisdiction logos and emblems for "Ordinary Fraternal Use" (i,e, activities that fall within the charitable and fraternal mission of the Knights of Columbus)

If you are unsure of whether the proposed use constitutes "Ordinary Fraternal Use" you should request permission from the Supreme Board of Directors for Supreme Brands and the State Deputy for Arizona Brands prior to their use. Council Supreme Compliance Status

Every Grand Knight and Program Director must complete Supreme Safe Environment Trained (SET) through Praesidium Academy. The Community Director and Family Directors are required to pass a background check in addition to this training. Once completed the training and background for the individual must be renewed every three years. The renewal date is different for every man, so close attention is needed to ensure the council does not fall out of compliance. Each man will receive a training invitation from Praesidium 45 days prior to his expiration. Sometimes this email will go to a spam folder, or the man has changed email address, so the information is not received. The Council Grand Knight can see each of the councils safe environment positions status and expiration dates in Officers Online. Once logged in go to: "Reports" then "Safe Environment

Member Status". If one of the required positions expire prior to June 30, 2025, make sure the man completes all Supreme requirements to stay in compliance.

Church Membership Drive Playbook

2-3 Weeks Prior

- Post dates of church drive on state calendar
- Run ads in church bulletin every week
- Organize teams of 6-8 brother knights for each mass
- Invite the Field Agent to help out
- Ask pastor/priests to promote the knights and encourage men to join

Day Of Event

- Greet parishioners before each mass
- Hand out K of C info to men and prayers cards to the ladies & children
- With Pastor's permission, give a 2-3 minute pulpit speech (note: have your best speaker do it, not always the GK)
- > Conclude pulpit announcement by reciting prayer on prayer card handed out (members distribute more during speech)
- Cover all exits after mass. Greet everyone but identify men that might be interested
- Funnel prospects to the "closers" on your team. Have agent code and team membership numbers available.
- Assist candidates with completing on-line membership <u>and</u> have candidate confirm while standing there
- Congratulate and welcome your new brother knight (and his family) with a smile and firm handshake!!

The Following Sunday

- Host A C-U-F Degree Ceremony immediately after the last mass of the day
- > Have The Ceremony in the church, of possible
- Host a luncheon/desserts & coffee/social event immediately after ceremony ends.

This will give you a chance to meet and learn about the new member and allow him to meet and greet his new brother knights!

- Ask new brothers to introduce themselves and their families before eating
- Have FinSec hand out membership cards before new members depart

We are finding that by following this playbook (with modifications unique to each council), we are having more success at not only getting members to join, but also getting them engaged early, providing the council with an influx of active members looking for programs to participate in.
