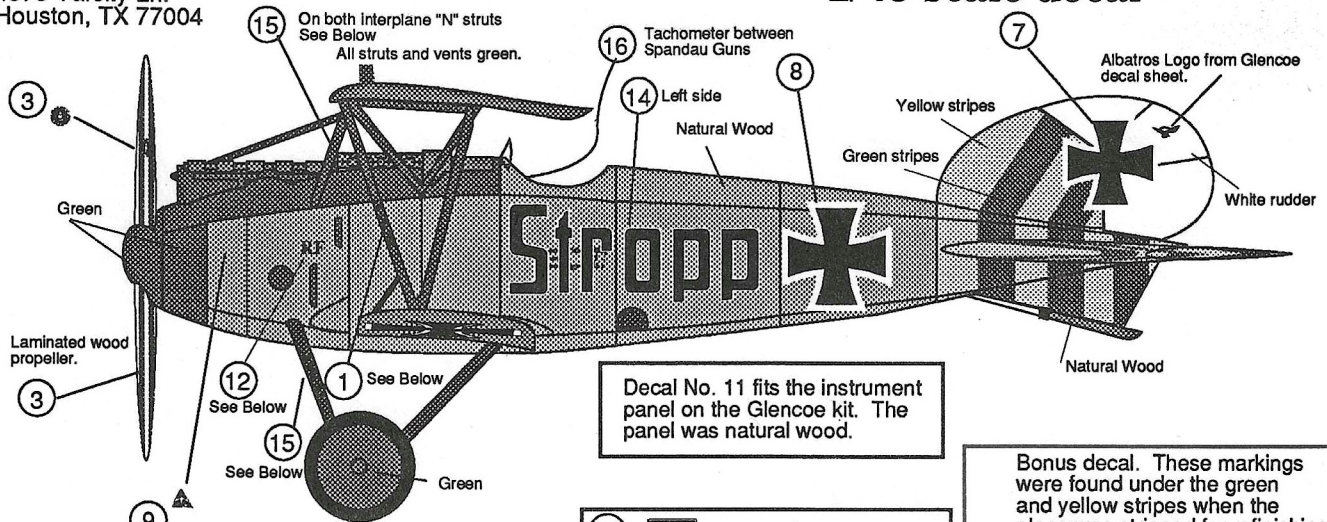

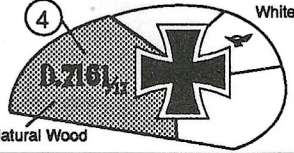
Albatros DVa "STROPP" 1/48 scale decal

Bonus decal. These markings were found under the green and yellow stripes when the plane was stripped for refinishing.

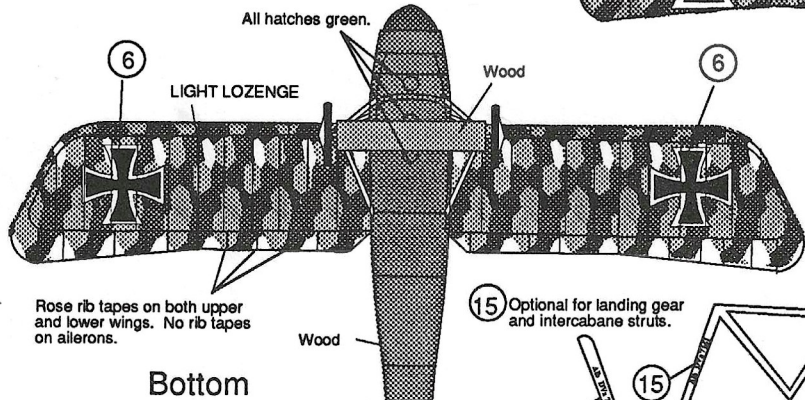
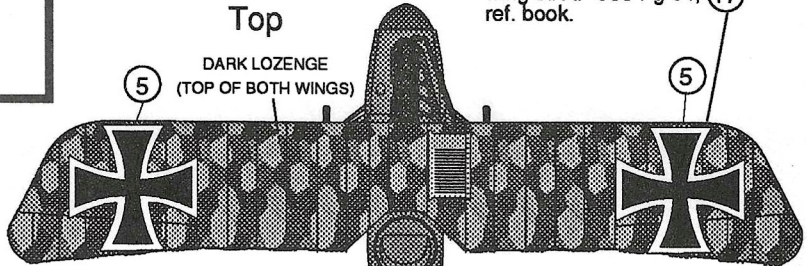

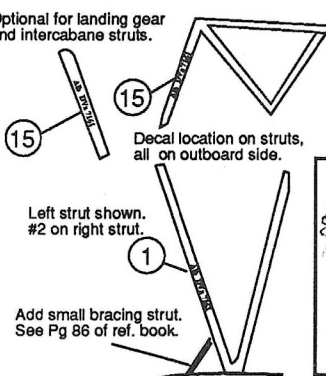
Anomometer on right wing strut. See Pg 84, ref. book.
